This will be a great opportunity for us to continue building unity within our parish, and the mid-run prayer time will surely be something special. Even if you're not able to join us in person, do partner with us in praying that, as we in SAC offer ourselves afresh to God. He will fulfil His kingdom purposes in and through us!

November will be our Missions Month. We'll be hearing a series of sermons that focus on mission both local and overseas, and our Missions Gathering will be held on 23 November. May our hearts be stirred as we hear about God's mission in the world and how we're called to participate in it! There'll be several mission and outreach opportunities coming up before the end of the year, such as the food distribution programme in Batam, English classes and ukulele classes for Myanmar nationals,

packing and distribution of Christmas gifts for residents at Bukit Merah View (BMV), and the "Christmas is Love" lunch party for BMV residents that will be held in SAC. Registration for the first run of the Alpha course in 2025 will also open in November. Will you ask God how He wants you to be a part of all this? Where, and to whom, does He wish to send you?

The season of Advent, the first season of the new Church year, will begin in December and lead up to Christmas. The word "advent" means arrival or coming, and during this season we will prepare ourselves for the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ (His first coming) as well as for His imminent return (His second coming). Although Christmas has become very commercial. it remains a wonderful opportunity for mission. When else during the year do you hear songs about Jesus playing in shopping malls? Will you ask God for an open door during this season to share the gospel with friends and family members who don't know Christ? Consider inviting them to join us for our Christmas services and events, praying that they'll encounter God in a life-changing manner.

Church, let us continue to grow as a community of disciples on mission for God. It has been said that the mark of a great church is not its seating capacity, but its sending capacity. As 2024 draws to a close, how will you allow God to use you to make SAC "great" in fulfilling His purpose and glorifying His name?

"When I was in Primary 5, CITY's Befrienders Club (BC) was a place where I could genuinely share my thoughts, feelings or concerns. It was the first time I felt a sense of belonging. BC helped me through a tough period, when I only had my mother. They helped me to spend my time productively, through lessons and the playing of tchoukball.

I was invited by my fellow BC befrienders to join the Befrienders Alumni programme (BFA) when I entered secondary school. I agreed because I enjoyed being part of the community.

BFA helped me in many different ways - from teaching me how to manage personal issues, assisting me in getting a scholarship, to giving me opportunities to serve as a Student Leader in CITY camps. BFA helped me to grow as a person. Without its guidance, I would have gone astray. I am grateful to the staff for imparting valuable life lessons to me and giving me the chance to serve BFA and the CITY community.

I am also thankful to have met my mentors, Michael and Phoebe, through BFA. During the lowest point of my life, they listened to me, guided me, and journeyed with me. They also shared the gospel with me. Initially I was skeptical, as I have had unpleasant experiences with Christians and churches in the past. However, Michael and Phoebe shared God's love with me in a warm and gentle manner, allowing me to experience God in a wonderful and loving way.

I accepted Jesus as my Saviour because of an answered prayer. At that time, I prayed and told Him that I would accept Him if I was granted an interview for a scholarship that I had applied


for. Not only was I granted the interview, I was eventually awarded the scholarship. I then believed that God was real and that God answered prayers. It is through CITY that I came to Christ."
