THE WORLD

Nepal is anticipating a third wave of COVID infections that is going to be worse than the present situation. Pray that God in His mercy will preserve lives. Pray that the Church in Nepal will be richly resourced to feed the poor, the needy and the fatherless through relief efforts; for God's healing and protection upon pastors and members of the Anglican Church in Nepal (ACN), many of whom, have been infected with the virus and for the timely provision of medical supplies to start the COVID Treatment Centres in Kathmandu and Dhading. Pray that many will encounter Christ in the midst of this crisis and that God grant wisdom to the authorities to alleviate the worsening COVID condition and the people's suffering.

SINGAPORE

Thank God that the proactive steps taken by our government are bearing fruit in the reduced number of community and unlinked cases; pray for divine wisdom to decide on how and when to gradually relax the heightened restrictions and for continued vigilance on the part of everyone. Pray also for divine guidance to reduce and even eradicate the increasing number of dengue cases in Singapore.

Yishun Church (Anglican)

Pray for Revd Daniel Teo and his family with his institution and induction as Vicar of Yishun Church (Anglican) on 20 June; for God's divine protection, presence and guidance to be upon them and for the empowering presence of the Holy Spirit to shepherd the flock in Yishun Church (Anglican).



SAC RESTORATION WORKS PROJECT, 2020-2022

This Project aims to repair and restore various parts of the Cathedral's historic building that have succumbed to

environmental wear and tear. The Restoration Works will involve replastering and re-painting of interior and exterior walls, timber carpentry, stone works, metal works, electrical works, plumbing and roof works. The Project is expected to take 3 years. The cost of \$6million will be paid out from the Cathedral Heritage Fund (CHF) set up to fund this Project as well as future heritage and building works.
