PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

South Korea & Malaysia

South Korea recently reported more than 1,000 daily new coronavirus cases, its worst-ever outbreak, spurred by the highly contagious Delta variant. Authorities have imposed the toughest restrictions yet in Seoul, where most of the new cases are found. However, these restrictions are making it hard for small businesses to stay afloat. Pray for the South Korean government and authorities to have divine wisdom as they seek to bring the rapid contagion under control; for small businesses to survive temporary closures, livelihoods to be preserved and for the people to stand together. Pray also for the speedy containment and reduction in the number of COVID-19 cases in Malaysia, which has risen to more than 11,000 on a particular day; for the speedy recovery of those infected and for increased healthcare facilities to cope with the influx of patients.

SINGAPORE

Pray for our government and medical authorities to have wisdom in pacing the re-opening of our economy safely, for our youths and elderly to be mentally resilient during this pandemic and for families to form strong bonds as they spend more time together at

home. Pray for the continued protection over our healthcare and frontline workers and their families.

DIOCESE

St James' Church

Pray that as St James' Church continues in its 2021 theme *Connect & Disciple*, together they will grow into a parish of disciples and disciple-makers. Pray for a renewal and revitalisation of the community life of the entire parish and for the church to raise more workers for the Lord's Kingdom work. Pray also for Revd Yap Chee Han and the Chinese Congregation as Revd Yap transitions in as priest to the Chinese Congregation.

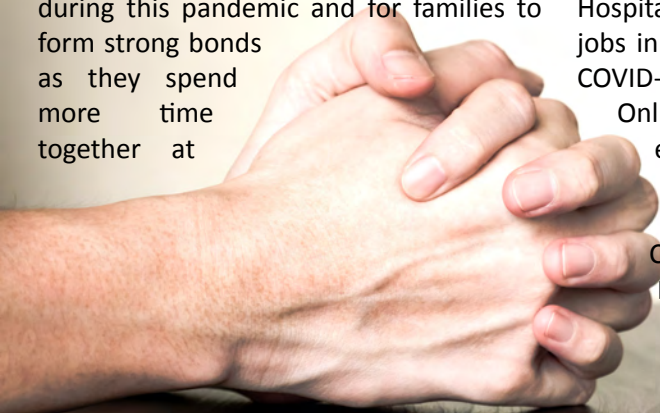

All entry points to the Cathedral will **open 30 mins** before service and **close 15 mins** after the start of service.

NAVE

- **Enter** via MRT Gate
- **SafeEntry** check-in at the linkway
- **Enter** via SRC gate
- **Park** only at the East Lawn carpark (facing Raffles City)
- **Drop-off** only at the shelter along linkway
- **SafeEntry** check-in at the linkway

CNS/PAVILION

- **Enter** via Welcome Centre
- **SafeEntry** check-in at lift lobby
- **Enter** via SRC gate
- **Park** only at the lots along the driveway towards Padang or Funan
- **Drop-off** only at the tent beside the West Porch (near Pavilion)
- **SafeEntry** check-in at lift lobby

FROM THE GROUND UP

Think Nehemiah. What comes to mind? He rallies the remnant of Israel and rebuilds the wall of Jerusalem in the face of incredible opposition. An amazing achievement of faith, unity, and perseverance! Relatively speaking, however, the wall of stone was the easier part. Nehemiah finished it in 52 days. Only then did his greatest work begin: the reformation of Israel postexile. Nehemiah spent the next 12 to 15 years of his life rebuilding the spiritual walls of Israel from the ground up. This was his great and lasting work. This is what he wanted to be remembered for. Not the

physical wall. But his faithfulness to duty (NEH 13:29-31).

From the Ground Up is the theme of this year's 40.Day prayer and fasting season. As we envision the new norm post-COVID, it's time to rethink Nehemiah—the man, the mandate, the message.

Please begin now by reading both Ezra and Nehemiah. These are one book in the Hebrew Bible. As you read, prepare your heart. Consecrate July 1st to August 9th as a season of seeking God. Together, in prayer and fasting, let us strengthen the walls of faith, hope, and love in the Singapore Church.

Re-imagining of Cathedral Welcome Centre (CWC)

Dear brothers & sisters in Christ, I have been tasked to lead a small group of members to take a fresh new look at the Welcome Centre and its ministry purposes and aims during this lull period as we continue to operate under severe restrictions. We believe that the CWC is our “window to the world”, a portal or interface that allows us to project ourselves to the world as well as a door through which seekers and those in need of solace and encouragement may enter. We believe that it should be *“A welcoming space to find solace and to be an oasis of peace & tranquility in the City.”*

Some of the options that are being considered are a heritage component with guided tours, an interactive multimedia historical display, an expanded area for books and gifts related to the Cathedral & the Diocese, Mission Deanery handicrafts for sale, weekly or fortnightly lunchtime TEDx style talks by Christians including marketplace leaders, weekly lunchtime musical performances, pastoral ministry to the distressed, meeting spaces catering to all age groups, Christmas displays and performances etc. We will still have coffee though the Cafe component of the re-imagined Welcome Centre is likely to be significantly different.

I am putting this message out to ask you to share your thoughts and ideas on what you think the purpose of this Welcome Centre should be and what should or should not be included. I am very open to all your suggestions (though, as you will understand, not all will be implemented). 

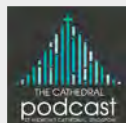

SAC RESTORATION WORKS PROJECT, 2020-2022

This Project aims to repair and restore various parts of the Cathedral's historic building that have succumbed to environmental wear and tear. The Restoration Works will involve re-plastering and re-painting of interior and exterior walls, timber carpentry, stone works, metal works, electrical works, plumbing and roof works. The Project is expected to take 3 years. The cost of \$6million will be paid out from the Cathedral Heritage Fund (CHF) set up to fund this Project as well as future heritage and building works.
