

THE WORLD

Collaboration by world leaders

The UN Development Programme chief Achim Steiner said that large parts of the world are facing the equivalent of a famine when it comes to vaccine equity. This is self-defeating because the pandemic will still keep coming back. Pray that rich countries will help poorer countries achieve a high rate of vaccination so that the world can stem the rising tide of COVID-19 infections. Pray also for world leaders to put aside their differences and work together to fight climate change in a race against time.

SINGAPORE

COVID-19 situation

Pray for the Ministry of Health as they closely monitor the recent spike in the number of cases to determine if it is a temporary spike or a further surge in infections and for wisdom to manage the COVID-19 situation in Singapore. Pray for protection over our unvaccinated seniors as daily infections among this group has risen to over 100 a day; for our hospitals to cope with the pressure and strain arising from the growing number of persons requiring ICU and for COVID-19 transmission in our nursing homes to be contained.

DIOCESE

Deanery of Laos

Praise God for His ongoing work in Laos where COVID-19 is making life difficult but God is still

bringing people to Christ through the work of Anglican Relief and Development Agency (ARDA) and Church of the Holy Spirit. Pray for a godly and wise replacement for Jeff Jaquith as ARDA National Director in May 2022. Jeff and his family have faithfully served for 14 years in Laos. Pray for the Jaquith family as they return to the USA in May 2022. Pray also for Revd lan Jennings and his wife Sue as they prepare to come to Laos in early 2022 to pastor the Church of the Holy Spirit (English Language) in Vientiane.

Pray for Revd Alvin Toh and his family as he assumes his new role as Vicar of SJSM; that God will grant him wisdom, strength and grace to shepherd the flock in SJSM in these challenging times.

Confirmation Course (beginning 24 Oct)



MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES IN THE YOUNG

A CONVERSATION WITH APROF. JOHN WONG CHEE MENG



Several fatal incidents over the last year involving youths have shocked the nation and turned the spotlight on what may just be the tip of the iceberg—and that is the prevalence of mental health issues in our young people in Singapore.

Singapore is a high pressure competitive society where the overwhelming desire to get ahead and stay ahead is ingrained early in life. Failure is not an option. The stresses that this produces are keenly felt in our vulnerable youths and may manifest psychologically, sometimes in a tragic manner.

In 2019, the AGM approved a major restoration of the Cathedral Nave, covering the plaster and painting of the external and internal walls of the main building and transepts, various repairs and electrical works. Since then, over \$5,000,000 has been raised towards the restoration. In June 2021, Cathedral appointed the contractor to undertake the works, which will start in January 2022 and take up to 12 months.

After considering the health and safety of the congregation and challenges to maintaining sanctity of worship under restoration conditions, the PCC together with the Mandarin Congregation Church Council (CC) decided to close the Nave during the restoration works.

The PCC and CC considered alternative sites for worship services. Some options involve significant costs, and possible continued restrictions to on-site worship due to COVID-19 added uncertainty. The PCC and CC working together, decided to exercise financial prudence, and use existing Cathedral facilities for worship services during the Nave closure.
