THE WORLD

World Health Organization experts warned that repeated booster shots of the original COVID-19 vaccines is not a sustainable strategy in the fight against COVID-19 and its emerging variants, though such vaccines may reduce the severity of the disease. Pray for breakthroughs in scientific research that will lead to the development of new vaccines that not only protect people against serious illness but also prevents infection and transmission of the variants. Pray that in the wake of this relentless virus, there will be a greater awakening in the hearts of humankind, to the need for God in their lives.

SINGAPORE

Pray for strength, wisdom and agility as our Multi-Ministerial Taskforce and Health Authorities continue to maintain vigilance and adjust their responses to the evolving COVID-19 situation. Pray for right decisions to be made as they balance the different needs of the vaccinated and the unvaccinated in our population. Pray that our healthcare system will have the capabilities to meet any exigencies and for the protection of our healthcare and

frontline workers. Pray for resilience and for national unity as we stand together to meet the challenges of this pandemic.





AGING GRACEFULLY & FINISHING WELL

A CONVERSATION WITH BISHOP EM. DR. ROBERT SOLOMON



Aging is inevitable. Growing old is not and finishing well certainly is not. There is much that we can do to make our lives count for Christ as we enter our silver or golden years. After all, Abraham only left Ur for Haran and then for Canaan at the ages of 70 and 75 respectively. Moses led the Hebrew slaves out of Egypt at the age of 80. By all estimates, about 20% of the population in Singapore will be above the age of 60 by the year 2030. Furthermore, all of us, at any age, are in full-time Christian service, whether we know it or not. How then are we to age gracefully and finish well?

Do join us for this Zoom conversation with Bishop Emeritus Dr. Robert Solomon as we explore how, as senior disciples, we might be as fruitful in our latter days as in our former. Bishop Solomon was Bishop of the Methodist Church in Singapore from 2000 to 2012. He is still a much sought after speaker, has spoken and taught ministry in many countries and in many settings and is also a prolific writer having authored 49 books, with the 50th book due to be released in April 2022. These books include *The Race, Faithful to the End, We are Pilgrims, Finding Rest for the Soul, Growing Old Gracefully,* and *A Grand Calling* (on grandparenting)
