

## Australia

Australia has reported about 1.6 million infections since the pandemic began, of which about 1.3 million were in the last few weeks. The nation is dealing with her worst COVID-19 outbreak, fuelled by the Omicron variant which has pushed hospitalisation rates to record levels. Pray that private hospitals will work closely with government authorities to meet the urgent need for medical personnel in Omicron-affected areas around the country. Pray also for the recovery of those infected with the virus, especially the unvaccinated young people.

## **Our Government**

Thank God for His protection over our nation and for sustaining us through the many challenges presented by COVID-19. Pray for wisdom as our government continues to manage the volatile COVID-19 situation, reshape our economy and

safeguard our national security. Pray also for good strategies to tackle climate change, to meet the needs of an ageing population and to steward our nation's resources.
