PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

The new variant Omicron has been spreading steadily across the world, beginning with S. Africa, to western countries and most recently to Asia. The number of global infections has increased fourfold in the last few weeks. Pray that poorer countries will have ready access to vaccines; for protection of the elderly, the vulnerable and healthcare workers, from infection. Pray also for sufficient hospital facilities, medical supplies and manpower to meet the rapid increase in demand within a short time.

Pray for God's sovereign and merciful intervention in Myanmar to bring an end to the political chaos, sufferings and senseless killings which has claimed many lives over the past one year. Pray for the restoration of justice and peace in this land.

SINGAPORE

Pray for continued and sustained efforts by our government to monitor the COVID-19 situation so that the Omicron variant will not overwhelm our healthcare system. Pray that safe management measures will be observed by all

especially during the forthcoming Chinese New Year celebrations. Pray for the effective containment and eradication of the Aedes aegypti mosquito population in Singapore.

A new dengue virus strain has been detected and dengue cases are expected to rise to levels which will exceed the 2021 case numbers. Pray for increased and urgent collective efforts by the public and sustained vector control efforts to effectively prevent an escalation of dengue case numbers to outbreak levels.

DIOCESE

Pray that God will grant His wisdom and empowering to those who are overseeing the work of St Andrew's Mission Hospital; that SAMH will be a channel of blessing to our nation and will fulfil God's plans for it in 2022. Pray that SAMH will be a light in society, relieving suffering and enriching lives with the love of Christ; that staff will serve with excellence in their various capacities to impact lives for the glory of God.

CATHEDRAL

Pray that Cathedral members will be passionate about evangelism and missions; that over the Chinese New Year period we will have many opportunities to share the gospel with loved ones and lead them to faith in Christ.

Pray that we will continue to reach out to one another in this pandemic and deepen our community life. Pray that we will unite around the vision that God has for us in 2022.

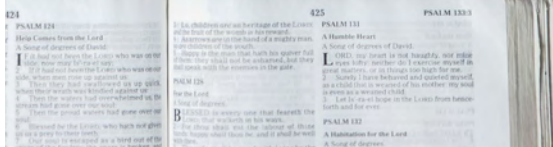
CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

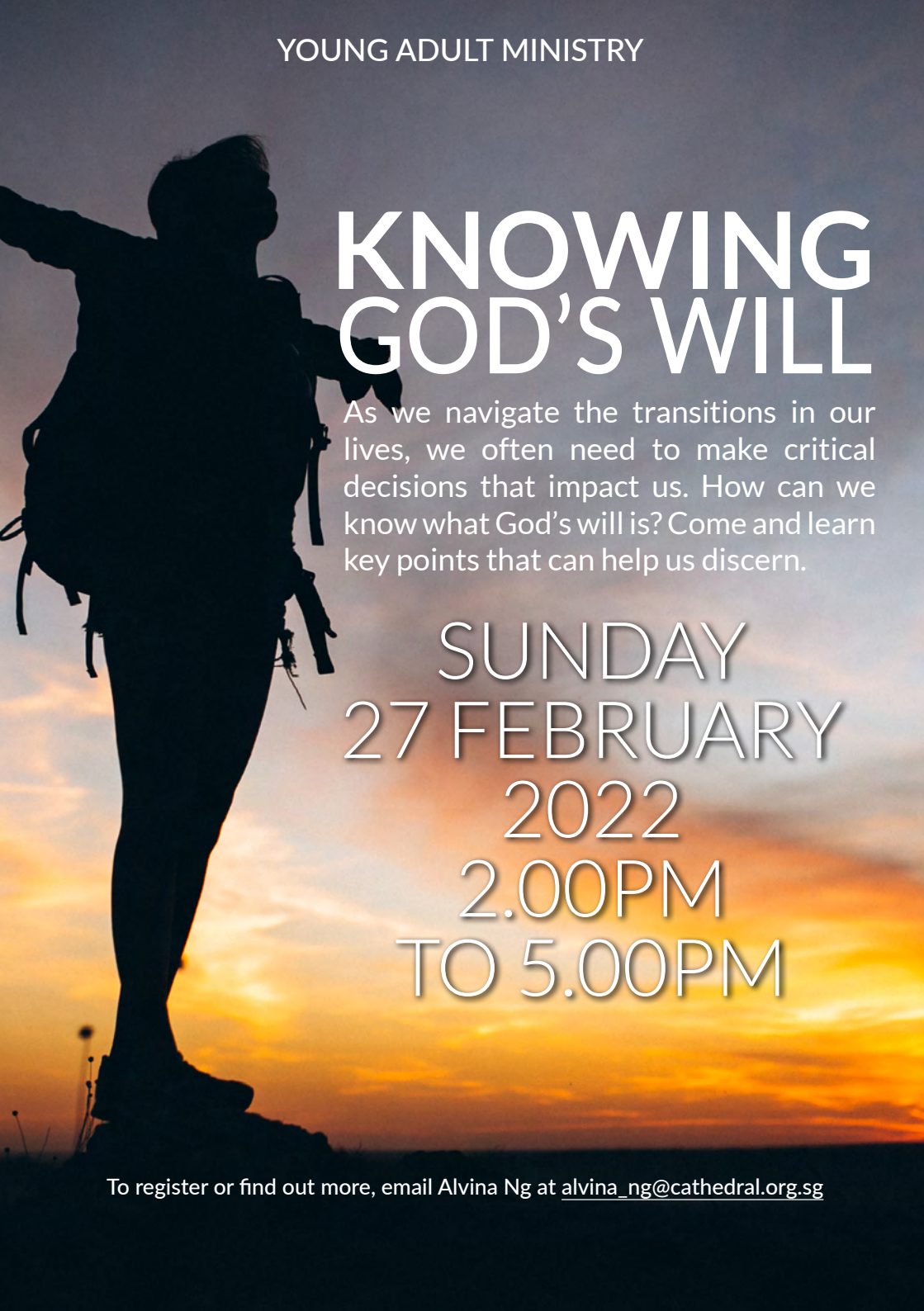

Archbishop's Message 2022

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

Together with my brother Bishops in our beloved Province, I bring greetings in the Priceless Name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

Amidst uncertainties of the future, nations are making every effort to return to certain degree of normalcy. Faced with chaos of a sort, resulted from the pandemic, we yearn for order to come into our lives, so that we can live our lives in peace. The nations of the world seek order and peace in our own ideas and wisdom, in science and human reasonings. However, we know from the revelation of God's words that true peace and order can only be found in Christ and in His Kingdom. Thus, Jesus taught His disciples and us to pray, "Thy kingdom come. "Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear." (Hebrews 12:28). With this confidence in God, let us move into 2022 with hope and great anticipation of what God is about to do. May His Kingdom come, His will be done, in our lives, on earth as it is in heaven!

May 2022 be a year we witness the increase of God's Kingdom and His righteousness in all areas of life!
