2 Corinthians 7:1

Someone asked me recently, “If we have to prioritise one thing in this season of revival and renewal, what would that be?” My answer was, “HOLINESS.” Saint Paul in writing to correct the erroneous teaching and lifestyles in the church of Corinth, exalted the believers to rid themselves of every defilement of body and spirit.

Israel became separated from God because they defiled themselves. They were disobedient to God’s commandments when they worshipped other gods, married foreign women and lived an immoral lifestyle. They had no fear of God.

Michael Reeves, the author of *Rejoice and Tremble*, pointed out that our society have lost God as the proper object of healthy fear, and God has been ousted from every aspect of our lives. Men have assumed the divine throne where we fear men more than we ever fear God. The shifting sands of both morality and reality have put us in an even more erroneous ground. While God in his mercy may not put us through a physical exile today, we can experience spiritual exile from God. We are in danger of becoming

totally helpless unless we return to our first love.

When we bring holiness to completion in the fear of God, we will experience the full spiritual transformation in our lives—a ‘renovation’ or renewal of our inner person, becoming an authentic disciple of Jesus Christ. That as I have mentioned in my sermon last weekend, will be the best Gospel that you will carry with you wherever you go. “Let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ” (Phil 1:27).

We have made some important adjustments in the last one month to our worship venue as the Nave goes through the restoration. I want to thank you for your patience and cooperation in adjusting to the new worship space. I want to especially mention a group of unsung heroes, our volunteers—the carpark marshals, ushers, sidespersons, AV crew and all personnel serving at the SafeEntry and Service stations, they have worked so hard to make this adjustment seamless.

As we enter into the month of February, the church will closely monitor the development of the COVID-19 situation in Singapore, and we are looking to increase the capacity once the situation stabilizes. The safety and health of our members remain our utmost priority in making the necessary considerations.

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PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

According to the World Health Organization, “the fast-spreading and heavily mutated Omicron variant has become the dominant variant worldwide. A sub-variant could be even more infectious than the original version and has been detected in 57 countries.” Pray for scientists to identify the characteristics, transmissibility and virulence of the sub-variants and for new vaccines to provide effective immunity against these variants. Pray for the gospel to advance with greater urgency as people acknowledge their need for God’s merciful intervention in this global crisis.

SINGAPORE

Pray for divine wisdom to strengthen global partnerships that will enhance socio/political and economic co-operation among countries. Pray for our Finance Minister Lawrence Wong who will deliver Singapore’s FY2022 Budget Statement on Friday, 18 February 2022 in Parliament; for wise fiscal policies that will promote growth in our foreign and domestic sectors as well as cater to the varying needs of different groups in our population.

As Christians, we must know how to respond, with grace, seasoned with salt, and know how to answer everyone (Col 4:6) We must see such challenges as opportunities to witness our faith and not pass judgment, as Jesus demonstrated in John 8:7.

Archbishop's Message 2022

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

Together with my brother Bishops in our beloved Province, I bring greetings in the Priceless Name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

Amidst uncertainties of the future, nations are making every effort to return to certain degree of normalcy. Faced with chaos of a sort, resulted from the pandemic, we yearn for order to come into our lives, so that we can live our lives in peace. The nations of the world seek order and peace in our own ideas and wisdom, in science and human reasonings. However, we know from the revelation of God's words that true peace and order can only be found in Christ and in His Kingdom. Thus, Jesus taught His disciples and us to pray, "Thy kingdom come.
