

e are into the third year of the COVID-19 pandemic and just as we thought we are getting out of this long drawn challenge of pestilence with the proposed ease of restrictions, we now see a spike in cases and increase in deaths globally. Meanwhile, we are extremely saddened and shocked by Russia's invasion of Ukraine. While we may be shocked and upset over the recent atrocities committed, we should not be surprised that all these are taking place. Scripture is very clear, "You will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not alarmed, for this must take place, but the end is not yet. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places. All these are but the beginning of the birth pains" (ESV, Matt. 24:6-8).

As we live in this end-time before the second coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, we are instructed to be on our guard (Mark. 13: 9a). We need to stand firm or to remain faithful in Christ in the midst of all that we are going through and experiencing. Humanly, we will not be able to deal with all these challenges with our human strength—we need the Lord, and we need to step-up our prayers. On our knees we will seek the Lord and find

the strength to overcome the season. "The one who endures to the end will be saved" (Matt. 24:13).

As we enter into the season of Lent, let's be reminded the call of our Lord to RETURN TO OUR FIRST LOVE, and we also want to heed the recent exhortation of Bishop Titus Chung to live Lent wisely. To help us to live Lent wisely, the church has prepared the Lent meditation for this year with the focus on the 'FATHER HEART OF GOD'. The series of meditations and prayers that follow is inspired by the book 'RETURN OF THE PRODIGAL SON-a Story of Homecoming' by Henri J.M. Nouwen. THE WORLD

Ukraine

Pray for God's supernatural protection over the Ukrainian people; that missiles shot into Ukraine will not land; for God's angelic hosts to encamp around every city; for the preservation of lives and property, for national unity and courage to stand against the Russian military forces. Pray for a total ceasefire and for a complete withdrawal of Russian troops from Ukraine, for peace and order to be restored and for Russia to respect the political sovereignty of Ukraine. Pray that in the midst of all the fighting, God's presence and power will be manifested and His Name will be exalted in the land.

SINGAPORE

Government & Our Children

Pray for God's divine wisdom to guide our government leaders as they join other nations in denouncing the Russian invasion of Ukraine and evaluate its impact on Singapore's economy. Pray for Singaporeans in Ukraine to remain calm, vigilant and safe as our Ministry of Foreign Affairs explores ways to assist them. Pray also for the children in our nation who are contracting COVID-19 at the highest rate; that they will be able to cope with the emotional impact of self-isolation which can

be very intimidating. Pray for parents as they manage care for their sick child, the safety of other family members as well as their own well-being.

DIOCESE

Chapel of the Holy Spirit

Pray for God's anointing upon Revd Peter Chen and the leadership as they lead the church towards becoming a witnessing community and a Great Commission Church. Pray that the church community may grow in their love for God and for one another; that they will be zealous in witnessing, deeply rooted in God's word and empowered by His Spirit to accomplish His will and purpose.

AGM ATTENDANCE

The 2022 Annual General Meeting ("the AGM") of the Parish of St Andrew's Cathedral ("the Cathedral") will be held on 24 April 2022 (Sunday) at 1pm by ZOOM Webinar. Members who wish to attend the AGM must register your intention to attend using the AGM 2022 Registration Form, via the Cathedral website or https://form.jotform.com/220161459536455, before 12 noon on 02 April 2022 (Saturday).

ELECTORAL ROLL

Members who wish to vote at the AGM must be on the Electoral Roll ("the ER") of St Andrew's Cathedral. Baptised members who are at least 17 years of age, confirmed in the Anglican Church, regularly attending Service and partaking Holy Communion in the Cathedral, are eligible to be on the ER. 15th February 2022 marked the 80th anniversary of the Fall of Singapore. During this dark period, St Andrew's Cathedral served as a symbol of hope, uniting men and women from different nations and backgrounds in a time of crisis. The Cathedral's Heritage Committee has commissioned this video to document this important story.

In the days immediately before and after the British surrender, the Cathedral was a place of refuge for the wounded. During the Japanese occupation, Bishop Leonard Wilson and other Christian leaders brought of different together churches denominations with the assistance of Andrew Tokuii Ogawa, an Anglican serving as an officer of the Japanese Imperial Army.


This story points to God's providence in meeting Singapore's spiritual and material needs, a message that is still important for us today.

The year 2022 marks the 80th anniversary of the Fall of Singapore. The Anglican Church played a key role in providing comfort during the War and its history was forever changed by it. NAVE RESTORATION PROJECT

UPDATE

The main contractor for the restoration work is Shanghai Chong Kee Furniture & Construction Pte Ltd. The works are carried out in 2 stages:

STAGE 1 | July 2021 to Dec 2021

- Contract and Documentation

The work included preparation of the project plan, documentation of the existing state of the Nave including an inventory of items (e.g. pews, plaques, artefacts), as well as method statements which are submitted to our conservation architect and regulatory authorities. Drawings for the replacement of electrical, AV, IT cables and aircon pipes, and their concealment in floor trenches to the full extent possible, also began at this time.









STAGE 2 | Jan 2022 to Dec 2022

- Site Work

Hoarding and the erection of external scaffolding has started but will only be completed in March. The furnishings in the Nave (pews, kneelers) have been moved offsite to the contractor's warehouse. These will be restored as needed or discarded if beyond repair.







