PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Ukraine

According to the UN Refugee Agency, more than 2 million Ukrainians have been displaced since Russia invaded Ukraine on 24 February this year. Pray for God's merciful intervention to restore peace and freedom in Ukraine; for the Holy Spirit to guide world leaders in their responses to this greatest crisis of humanity since World War 2, as it has grave repercussions on the rest of the world. Pray for God's comfort over the people who face much uncertainty and fear; for families which are torn apart as women and children take refuge in neighboring countries and men stay behind to fight. Pray for organizations which are involved in humanitarian efforts to provide timely aid to alleviate the suffering of the people. Pray that many will come to know Christ as the one true source of hope, peace, safety, comfort, truth and freedom (adapted from the Bible Society of Singapore's Prayer Appeal for Ukraine).

SINGAPORE

Pray for divine protection over Singapore's national security against internal and external threats; for continued social cohesion, religious and social harmony in the midst of global challenges. Pray for wisdom to guide

our government leaders as they continue to monitor and make changes to our healthcare protocols, changes to our educational system and embark on initiatives to protect our environment. Pray for our doctors to cope with the heavy patient load from the Omicron wave.

DIOCESE

My Savior's Church

Pray that the parish will find creative means to continue the ministry of evangelism and that every member of the parish will take part in evangelism. Pray for spiritual growth in the church and that God will give the parish the discernment in choosing the right people for the PCC in the coming AGM.

AGM ATTENDANCE

The 2022 Annual General Meeting ("the AGM") of the Parish of St Andrew's Cathedral ("the Cathedral") will be held on 24 April 2022 (Sunday) at 1pm by ZOOM Webinar. Members who wish to attend the AGM must register your intention to attend using the AGM 2022 Registration Form, via the Cathedral website or https://form.jotform.com/220161459536455, before 12 noon on 02 April 2022 (Saturday).

ELECTORAL ROLL

Members who wish to vote at the AGM must be on the Electoral Roll ("the ER") of St Andrew's Cathedral. Baptised members who are at least 17 years of age, confirmed in the Anglican Church, regularly attending Service and partaking Holy Communion in the Cathedral, are eligible to be on the ER. Members may check if you are on the ER by completing the ER Enquiry Form https://form.jotform.com/220162000761438.

Members who are on the ER may vote at the AGM only by appointing the Chairman of the AGM (who is the Vicar of the Cathedral) as your proxy to attend, speak and vote on

your behalf at the AGM. You may so appoint the Vicar as your proxy by submitting a duly completed Proxy Voting Form. Eligible members may obtain the Proxy Voting Form by submitting the duly completed **AGM 2022 Registration Form** before 12 noon on 02 April 2022 (Saturday).

15th February 2022 marked the 80th anniversary of the Fall of Singapore. During this dark period, St Andrew's Cathedral served as a symbol of hope, uniting men and women from different nations and backgrounds in a time of crisis. The Cathedral's Heritage Committee has commissioned this video to document this important story.

In the days immediately before and after the British surrender, the Cathedral was a place of refuge for the wounded. During the Japanese occupation, Bishop Leonard Wilson and other Christian leaders brought of different together churches denominations with the assistance of Andrew Tokuii Ogawa, an Anglican serving as an officer of the Japanese Imperial Army.


This story points to God's providence in meeting Singapore's spiritual and material needs, a message that is still important for us today.

The year 2022 marks the 80th anniversary of the Fall of Singapore. The Anglican Church played a key role in providing comfort during the War and its history was forever changed by it. NAVE RESTORATION PROJECT

UPDATE

The main contractor for the restoration work is Shanghai Chong Kee Furniture & Construction Pte Ltd. The works are carried out in 2 stages:

STAGE 1 | July 2021 to Dec 2021

- Contract and Documentation

The work included preparation of the project plan, documentation of the existing state of the Nave including an inventory of items (e.g. pews, plaques, artefacts), as well as method statements which are submitted to our conservation architect and regulatory authorities. Drawings for the replacement of electrical, AV, IT cables and aircon pipes, and their concealment in floor trenches to the full extent possible, also began at this time.









STAGE 2 | Jan 2022 to Dec 2022

- Site Work

Hoarding and the erection of external scaffolding has started but will only be completed in March. The furnishings in the Nave (pews, kneelers) have been moved offsite to the contractor's warehouse. These will be restored as needed or discarded if beyond repair.







