Richard Magnus

1944 - 2022

We remember the late Mr Richard Magnus, Chancellor of The Diocese of Singapore, who passed on to glory on 14 March 2022. He was 77.

Mr Magnus served as the Diocese of Singapore's Registrar from 1993 to 2005 and Chancellor from 2006 to 2022. As the Registrar and Chancellor, he worked closely with the Diocesan Bishop on matters relating to the diocese.

The late Mr Magnus was also instrumental in setting up the HR Task Force in 2014 to look into the welfare of the servants of the Lord. Having a heart for those who are vulnerable, he served and contributed through St Andrew's Mission Hospital and Singapore Anglican Community services.

Mr Magnus also contributed much to the public service, having retired as a Chief District Judge after 40 years in the Singapore legal service. He also held key leadership and advisory positions in various boards and committees.

He was most recently conferred the Distinguished Service Order for the 2021 National Day Awards for his contributions to the public service. He had also received the Public Administration Medal (Gold) (Bar) in 2003, the Meritorious Service Medal in 2009, and the Public Service Star Medal in 2015.

Affectionately known as 'Brother Richard' to some, the late Mr Magnus was a spiritual friend and leader to many. Those who have served alongside him will attest to his love for the Lord and His people. Mr Magnus will be dearly missed by many whose lives he had touched.

He was also a "loving husband, wonderful father, and devoted grandfather," said his son, Keith Magnus, in an interview with The Straits Times. Our thoughts and prayers are with his wife, Mrs Eileen Magnus, and their two children and three grandchildren.

PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Ukraine

Pray for humanitarian aid to reach the besieged Ukrainian city of Mariupol which has been turned into “a desolate wasteland of bombed out buildings, many in flames, with smoke pouring into the sky” (The Straits Times, 15 Mar 2022) and for civilians to be moved to places of safety. Pray for divine protection over the cities in Ukraine and over the people especially the elderly, the young and the vulnerable. Pray for the many rounds of talks between Ukrainian and Russian delegates to yield constructive results and for world leaders to act collectively and effectively in bringing an end to the military action against Ukraine.

SINGAPORE

Thank God that the Omicron wave appears to have peaked and is gradually subsiding. Pray for our Multi-Ministerial Taskforce as they continue to monitor the situation; for the general public to be vigilant in observing the streamlined COVID-19 safety measures (which took effect on 15 March) and for further easing of measures to be introduced at the right time and under the right conditions to allow for normal activities to safely resume.

St John's Chapel

Pray that the Vicar Revd John Lin will have divine wisdom to lead and shepherd the flock in St John's Chapel, during such challenging times; for the church community to experience God's love and grace in this season of repentance, restoration and renewal. Pray for God to provide a new chaplaincy staff for the students of St Margaret's Secondary School and for missionaries Gerry and Yahui Gan, that they will bear much fruit in the mission field of Chiang Mai, Thailand.

Yishun Christian Church

Pray for the Vicar Revd Daniel Teo, Pastoral Staff and PCC as they adjust to the many changes in this pandemic; for fresh, creative ideas to connect with members and establish pastoral care. Pray that they will work towards the vision to grow in Christ-likeness toward spiritual maturity; for the smooth transition of Praiseland KinderCare to Anglican Preschool Services and for dedicated teachers who will inspire the children in their learning.

AGM ATTENDANCE

ELECTORAL ROLL

NAVE RESTORATION PROJECT

UPDATE

The main contractor for the restoration work is Shanghai Chong Kee Furniture & Construction Pte Ltd. The works are carried out in 2 stages:

■ **STAGE 1** | July 2021 to Dec 2021

- **Contract and Documentation**

The work included preparation of the project plan, documentation of the existing state of the Nave including an inventory of items (e.g. pews, plaques, artefacts), as well as method statements which are submitted to our conservation architect and regulatory authorities. Drawings for the replacement of electrical, AV, IT cables and aircon pipes, and their concealment in floor trenches to the full extent possible, also began at this time.



■ **STAGE 2** | Jan 2022 to Dec 2022

- **Site Work**

Hoarding and the erection of external scaffolding has started but will only be completed in March. The furnishings in the Nave (pews, kneelers) have been moved offsite to the contractor's warehouse. These will be restored as needed or discarded if beyond repair.
