

PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Ukraine

Pray for God's merciful, divine intervention to bring an end to the Russian invasion of Ukraine; for the opening of more humanitarian corridors to evacuate civilians from besieged towns and cities; for humanitarian aid to reach millions of internally displaced Ukrainians especially those in Mariupol who have no access to food, water, power and medicine. Pray against human trafficking and for divine protection over women and children who have fled Ukraine to seek refuge in neighbouring countries. Pray also for wisdom and unity as world leaders work together to resolve this crisis.

China

Pray for the families of those who lost loved ones in the China Eastern plane crash on 21 March; for investigations to uncover the cause of the crash and for all necessary protocols to ensure aviation safety and avert such disasters in the future.

SINGAPORE

Pray for good international relations with global partners that will promote economic cooperation, growth and national security;

for excellent management of the COVID-19 situation that will enable us to increasingly reopen our borders safely. Pray also for creative strategies that will enable our nation's power sector to achieve net-zero emissions within a viable time frame.

DIOCESE

Deanery of Cambodia

Thank God that the onsite English Service has reopened after going online for 3 weeks due to Omicron infection. Pray that pastors who have received training recently, will be equipped to teach and preach God's word faithfully; for the food relief programme to reach the needy and for the provision of a good contractor to construct a dormitory in Pursat for girls from poor families in the surrounding villages.

Thank God for the 25 brothers and sisters (20 adults and 5 infants) who have decided to make a public declaration of their inward faith through the sacrament of water baptism on 26 March. Pray that they will continue to cultivate an intimate relationship with our Lord and grow towards spiritual maturity as faithful disciples of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Notice is hereby given that the 2022 Annual General Meeting of the Parish of St Andrew's Cathedral will be held on 24 April 2022 (Sunday) at 1pm (Singapore time) via 700M Webinar.

AGM ATTENDANCE

The 2022 Annual General Meeting ("the AGM") of the Parish of St Andrew's Cathedral ("the Cathedral") will be held on 24 April 2022 (Sunday) at 1pm by ZOOM Webinar. Members who wish to attend the AGM must register your intention to attend using the AGM 2022 Registration Form, via the Cathedral website or https://form.jotform.com/220161459536455, before 12 noon on 02 April 2022 (Saturday).

ELECTORAL ROLL

Members who wish to vote at the AGM must be on the Electoral Roll ("the ER") of St Andrew's Cathedral. Baptised members who are at least 17 years of age, confirmed in the Anglican Church, regularly attending Service and partaking Holy Communion in the Cathedral, are eligible to be on the ER. Members may check if you are on the ER by completing the ER Enquiry Form https://form.jotform.com/220162000761438.

OUORUM AND VOTING AT THE AGM

Members who are on the ER may vote at the AGM only by appointing the Chairman of the AGM (who is the Vicar of the Cathedral) as your proxy to attend, speak and vote on

your behalf at the AGM. You may so appoint the Vicar as your proxy by submitting a duly completed Proxy Voting Form. Eligible members may obtain the Proxy Voting Form by submitting the duly completed **AGM 2022 Registration Form** before 12 noon on 02 April 2022 (Saturday).

NAVE RESTORATION PROJECT

UPDATE

The main contractor for the restoration work is Shanghai Chong Kee Furniture & Construction Pte Ltd. The works are carried out in 2 stages:

STAGE 1 | July 2021 to Dec 2021

- Contract and Documentation

The work included preparation of the project plan, documentation of the existing state of the Nave including an inventory of items (e.g. pews, plaques, artefacts), as well as method statements which are submitted to our conservation architect and regulatory authorities. Drawings for the replacement of electrical, AV, IT cables and aircon pipes, and their concealment in floor trenches to the full extent possible, also began at this time.









STAGE 2 | Jan 2022 to Dec 2022

- Site Work

Hoarding and the erection of external scaffolding has started but will only be completed in March. The furnishings in the Nave (pews, kneelers) have been moved offsite to the contractor's warehouse. These will be restored as needed or discarded if beyond repair.





