

THE WORLD

Ukraine

Pray for Ukrainians fleeing the war to have safe passage to neighboring countries; for the Red Cross and other humanitarian agencies as they coordinate efforts to care for the needs of refugees and those still trapped in Ukraine without food, water, medicine or power. Pray for an end to the suffering, the loss of lives and property. Pray for a permanent solution to the crisis, for restoration of hope in the midst of despair and deep darkness. Pray that many will hear the gospel and commit their lives to the Lord.

SINGAPORE

Government

Pray for our government to have divine wisdom and foresight as they plan Singapore's future and safeguard our nation against internal and external threats. Pray for safe travel as more Singaporeans go abroad for business or leisure. Pray for continued watchfulness as Singapore eases restrictions to allow for larger group sizes to meet and opens her borders to more countries. Pray that we will be quick to adapt to changes and adjust to different scenarios in the new normal.

Pray for the new Vicar, Revd Ian Chew, staff team and leaders that they may serve God in unity and under the anointing of the Holy Spirit. Pray for

NAVE RESTORATION PROJECT

UPDATE

The main contractor for the restoration work is Shanghai Chong Kee Furniture & Construction Pte Ltd. The works are carried out in 2 stages:

STAGE 1 | July 2021 to Dec 2021

- Contract and Documentation

The work included preparation of the project plan, documentation of the existing state of the Nave including an inventory of items (e.g. pews, plaques, artefacts), as well as method statements which are submitted to our conservation architect and regulatory authorities. Drawings for the replacement of electrical, AV, IT cables and aircon pipes, and their concealment in floor trenches to the full extent possible, also began at this time.









STAGE 2 | Jan 2022 to Dec 2022

- Site Work

Hoarding and the erection of external scaffolding has started but will only be completed in March. The furnishings in the Nave (pews, kneelers) have been moved offsite to the contractor's warehouse. These will be restored as needed or discarded if beyond repair.





