# PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

### THE WORLD

#### Ukraine

Pray for the protection of women and children in Ukraine and for timely humanitarian aid to reach the people in besieged cities. Pray against the use of weapons of mass destruction; for negotiations between Ukrainian and Russian leaders to open up more humanitarian corridors. Pray for common ground to be reached by both countries and for an end to the war.

### China

Pray that the surge of COVID-19 cases in Shanghai will drop quickly and drastically; for residents to gain access to food and medical care. Pray that the city's healthcare system will remain robust to cope with the number of infected people and for special protection over the elderly who are lagging in vaccinations.

### **SINGAPORE**

A total of 2,141 child abuse cases were investigated in Singapore last year. This is the highest number in a decade. Pray for the Ministry of Social & Family Development as it steps up efforts to tackle family violence in Singapore. Pray for effective implementation of measures which include raising public awareness, providing social service support to individuals and families as well as legal protection for survivors. Pray also for the successful rehabilitation of perpetrators of family violence.

### St George's Church

Thank God for giving St George's Church the privilege of being able to share the gospel over Easter to many visitors. Pray that the good news faithfully proclaimed will find good soil in all who attend and change lives for eternity. Thank God for last year's Parochial Church Council and pray for the new leaders who will be elected at St George's AGM on 25th April.

### St Peter's Church

Pray that every member of St Peter's Church will be a growing disciple of Jesus Christ. Pray that the funds for the building renovation project will be raised quickly and that the church's community outreach work will bring many souls into the Kingdom of God.

### NAVE RESTORATION PROJECT

UPDATE

The main contractor for the restoration work is Shanghai Chong Kee Furniture & Construction Pte Ltd. The works are carried out in 2 stages:

### **STAGE 1** | July 2021 to Dec 2021

### - Contract and Documentation

The work included preparation of the project plan, documentation of the existing state of the Nave including an inventory of items (e.g. pews, plaques, artefacts), as well as method statements which are submitted to our conservation architect and regulatory authorities. Drawings for the replacement of electrical, AV, IT cables and aircon pipes, and their concealment in floor trenches to the full extent possible, also began at this time.









### **STAGE 2** | Jan 2022 to Dec 2022

### - Site Work

Hoarding and the erection of external scaffolding has started but will only be completed in March. The furnishings in the Nave (pews, kneelers) have been moved offsite to the contractor's warehouse. These will be restored as needed or discarded if beyond repair.





