THE WORLD

Ukraine

Pray for Ukraine and Russia to reach a consensus that will bring an end to the horrific suffering and bloodshed of war. Pray for sustained efforts to transport refugees to safety and for humanitarian aid to reach those who are still trapped in ravaged cities.

Sri Lanka

Massive demonstrations in Sri Lanka have been ongoing for weeks. The people are protesting against the government's mismanagement of the economy. The peaceful demonstrations have broken out into clashes with the police resulting in death and injuries. Pray against the eruption of increased violence and for the restoration of political stability in this nation.

SINGAPORE

Pray for good relationship and cooperation between Singapore and New Zealand as leaders of both countries work together on climate change and the green economy. Pray for the Minister for Sustainability and the Environment Grace Fu and her team as they analyse coastal and inland flood data, harness new technologies and find creative solutions to tackle rising sea levels. Pray also for Finance Minister

Lawrence Wong as he prepares to lead the 4G team in the service of our nation.

Deanery of Laos

Praise God for Jeff and Coiya Jacquith's 16 years of faithful and exceptional service in Laos. Pray for them and their 3 children as they adjust to living in the United States from 1 May. NAVE RESTORATION PROJECT

UPDATE

The main contractor for the restoration work is Shanghai Chong Kee Furniture & Construction Pte Ltd. The works are carried out in 2 stages:

STAGE 1 | July 2021 to Dec 2021

- Contract and Documentation

The work included preparation of the project plan, documentation of the existing state of the Nave including an inventory of items (e.g. pews, plaques, artefacts), as well as method statements which are submitted to our conservation architect and regulatory authorities. Drawings for the replacement of electrical, AV, IT cables and aircon pipes, and their concealment in floor trenches to the full extent possible, also began at this time.









STAGE 2 | Jan 2022 to Dec 2022

- Site Work

Hoarding and the erection of external scaffolding has started but will only be completed in March. The furnishings in the Nave (pews, kneelers) have been moved offsite to the contractor's warehouse. These will be restored as needed or discarded if beyond repair.


