

PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

According to the United Nations, more than 5.5 million Ukrainians have fled their country since Russia's invasion on 24 Feb. This has been called Europe's fastest-growing refugee crisis since World War II. Pray for the protection of all women and children refugees against sexual violence and abuses. Pray for healing from the trauma and the loss of everything, as a result of the war. Although civilians have been evacuated from the Azovstal steelworks in Mariupol, hundreds of Ukrainian defenders are still under siege in the plant which has come under heavy bombardment. Pray for the safety of these defenders and for their miraculous deliverance in the midst of depleting food supplies, medicines and fuel. Pray for peaceful negotiations to bring an end to the war.

SINGAPORE

Pray for foresight and insight as our government leaders continue to build and strengthen good international relationships with world leaders; for continued vigilance and protection against radicalization and external threats to our national security. Pray also for wisdom to effectively deal with the increasing number of dengue fever cases in Singapore.

DIOCESE

St Hilda's Church

Pray for the Lord's anointing upon the Vicar, Revd Martin Jungnickel as he leads the church; for the Lord to bless the work of the pastoral and administrative staff with fruitfulness. Pray that the newly elected PCC will be empowered and guided by the Holy Spirit as they begin a new term of service. Pray also that members will encounter God afresh during their Church Camp (5-7 June at Sentosa Oasia) through the ministry of Dr. Paul Woods.

Pray that Revd Edwin Tan and his team will have divine wisdom and strength to shepherd the congregation in St Andrew's City Church; that the church will be a light and a channel of God's love, to the communities around them.

Update on Nave Restoration Works

Hoarding works and the erection of external scaffolding has been progressing slowly; scaffolding over the East Wing is up but it has yet to make its way to cover the North end of the building.

Inside the Nave, areas of hollowness in the wall plaster have been identified, and the removal of hollow wall plaster is in progress. Mock-ups have been constructed showing the placement of the new fans and lights. Workers have taken down the wall plaques that can be removed, in preparation for the cleaning of the plaques. Method statements on how to clean the different plaques (which are constructed with different materials) are being prepared. The wood organ pipes at the gallery have been covered up, and the smaller pipes will be taken down and packed away in crates for protection, in preparation for the next phase of the restoration works.

As we expect more workers to be present at the worksite from May, please pray for God's favour over the restoration – for skilled workers onsite, a safe and peaceful

environment for work to continue. minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources, and wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work. "Unless the LORD builds the builders house, the labour in vain" applies verv much to the restoration of this building.


