PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

At the World Economic Forum in May this year, business leaders and policymakers have voiced their concerns over a growing world food crisis. The global food distribution network was already strained by pandemic-related disruptions, and the war in Ukraine (one of the world's breadbaskets) has seriously affected Ukraine's ability to produce and export grain. Pray that Ukraine's sea ports will be re-opened to export millions of tonnes of corn, wheat and sunflower seeds to world markets. Pray also for countries which are facing severe food shortages, to receive urgent humanitarian aid.

SINGAPORE

Pray that Singapore will maintain good and amicable relations with all countries in the midst of increasing geo-political tensions arising from the war in Ukraine and territorial disputes over the South China Sea. Pray for wisdom to guide our foreign policy, for protection against threats to our national security and for sustainable strategies to safeguard our nation's food security.

DIOCESE

Theological Education Board

Pray for Revd Dr Joshua Sudharman, Warden of St Peter's Hall and Diocesan Training, and

Revd William Chee, Lay Training Coordinator and School Leader at St Peter's Hall; that they will be guided by divine wisdom as they plan the curriculum, organize teams of writers and lay a strong foundation for the comprehensive and effective training of our clergy and laity. Pray also for staff of Trinity Theological College and other bible colleges to provide excellent training that will equip their students for full time ministry.

Deanery of Vietnam

Pray for the deanery's leadership development programme; for more workers to be raised up to serve in various roles and prepare for the future growth of the deanery. Pray for favour in the application process to register the denomination in Vietnam; that this will pave the way for greater growth in the future. Pray for the church planting work in Halong, Hung Yen, and Binh Chanh; that the Lord will strengthen the core teams and send forth the workers into these harvest fields.

Appointment of Dr Stanley Lai as Chancellor of the Diocese of Singapore

Bp Titus Chung announced the appointment of Dr Stanley Lai as the Chancellor of the Diocese of Singapore with immediate effect at the 25th Synod Meeting on 21 May 2022. Dr Stanley Lai currently serves as a member of the Diocesan Standing Committee, and helms the Diocesan HR Board as its Chairman. He is an active member of the Provincial Synod and Provincial Standing Committee.

Dr Stanley Lai has also represented the Province of South East Asia on the Anglican Consultative Council. He chaired the Virtual AGM Taskforce

in 2020, and was instrumental in guiding our parishes through the new and permissible ways to conduct their AGMs in the midst of the pandemic.

In St Andrew's Cathedral, Dr Stanley Lai holds various responsibilities in the PCC and serves as a member of the music ministry at the 9.30am service. He was the first Singapore-born lawyer to be conferred a PhD in Law from the University of Cambridge in 1999 and was appointed Senior Counsel in 2010.

We uphold Dr Stanley Lai and his family in prayer as he takes on these new and significant responsibilities, praying for the Lord's wisdom and guidance upon him in discharging them.

Update on Nave Restoration Works

The Scaffolding has been erected at the North East side of the building and is expected to reach the North west side (West Porch) in 2 weeks' time.

Inside the Nave, removal of the hollow plaster areas has begun along the columns and walls from about 2m upwards. Mapping work for hollowness at the higher areas from the base of the arches are in progress. Removal of the plaster at these higher areas will commence once

the proposal is seen and approved by the consultants.

Works on rising dampness are in progress. These are carried out at the water point areas found at both the entrances to the North and South Transepts.

While work has been progressing slowly due to various reasons including a shortage of workers, we understand that the contractor will be allocating more workers to the project going forward. We expect work to pick up from June with more workers working at both the external and internal of the building.

Please pray for God's favour over the restoration – for more skilled workers to be available, a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue, minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources, and wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams





to give of their best to this work. "Unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labour in vain" applies very much to the restoration of this building.
