

Dear Members of St. Andrew's Cathedral,

At his National Day Rally speech on 21 Aug 2022, PM Lee announced the government's decision to repeal Section 377A of the Penal Code, as well as the intention to constitutionally safeguard the institution of marriage between a man and a woman in Singapore. We are thankful for the PM's assurance that the government will protect the definition of marriage from legal challenges.

Following PM's speech, Bishop Titus Chung issued a pastoral letter to our parishioners to state the views and positions of our Diocese on this matter. The National Council of Churches of Singapore (NCCS) also released a statement on behalf of the Protestant church in Singapore. Both are attached for your perusal.

While we wait for this matter to be debated in parliament, what is of foremost importance at this point, is for us to put aside our personal views and opinions, and instead come together as one people united by the blood of Christ, to pray for our national leaders. Pray for God's divine wisdom and guidance, and pray for godly courage to do what is morally right and necessary to protect families and marriages.

As Bishop Titus mentioned, this matter highlighted a glaring gap in our church, in our understanding of marriage and sexuality. To address this, our Christian Education (CE) department, together with our Family Life Ministry (FLM), will be organising dialogue sessions for members to have a better and holistic understanding of marriage and sexuality from a scriptural perspective. Special dialogue sessions specifically for youths will be organised, and resources to aid parents in having meaningful discussions with their young children on the topic of sexuality will also be made available.

Let's unite as one in Christ, as Cathedral continues to uphold the clear truth of Scripture, and minister this truth with love and compassion, to His praise and glory!

Statement from the National Council of Churches Singapore

PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Global security cannot be taken for granted amid worsening United States-China ties and Russia's invasion of Ukraine. The two powers are divided over many issues such as ideologies, systems of government, as well as specific problems, which include trade disputes, cyber espionage, the South China Sea and Hong Kong. The war in Ukraine has also complicated alreadystrained US-China relations, as well as relations between China and America's partners in Asia. This affects security in the Asia-Pacific region (PM Lee's National Day Rally speech). Pray for constructive talks between the U.S and China, for the healing of diplomatic relations which have been severely strained, for common ground to be reached and for the restoration of cooperation on urgent global issues.

SINGAPORE

Pray for our government to have wisdom and discernment as they deal with the issues relating to the repeal of S377A of the Penal Code and the concerns arising therefrom. Pray for clarity, clear communication and good engagement between our government and citizens.

DIOCESE

Deanery of Vietnam

Pray that the Lord will send forth more workers into this growing harvest field; for divine favor with government authorities as the Deanery seeks to officially register our denomination and the individual churches. Pray for God's wisdom and provision to set up an Anglican Centre for Theological Studies in Ho Chi Minh City by 2023.

Baptism-Confirmation Course

Update on Nave Restoration Works

e praise and thank God for His wonderful provisions. We have recently seen a promising increase of workers on the site which has in turn, brought about an increase in work activities at both the internal and external of the main building. Arrangements are underway for more workers to come on board, which should help us better the percentage of the catch-up programme work. While the contractor is behind schedule, the contractor is making effort to catch-up with the Master Schedule.

Works on the external scaffolding are nearing completion. It has reached the South side of the building and will be making its way to the East Side of the building within 2 weeks.

The removal of paint at the East Side external walls have commenced and the removal of hollow plaster will take place this coming week. Special care was taken to remove the different layers of paint from the emblems at the North Side Balconies of the building. This will help us to ascertain the original colour of wall of bricks the emblems as well as to preserve its artwork.

The sub-contractor that was invited to quote for the erection of the scaffold of the Bell Tower has withdrawn its bid. The contractor will continue to invite others to quote for the works, and we hope and pray that the contractor will be able to keep to the August schedule for the erection of the scaffold at the Bell Tower to start.

Inside the Nave, removal of the areas of hollow plaster at the South and West side are nearing completion. Works on the North Side will commence this coming week. Rising damp treatment, biocide as well as salt treatment will take place at the North Side once the plasters are removed. Paint removal is in progress at areas that do not need plaster removal.

Please continue to pray for God's favour over the restoration – for skilled workers to be available, a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue, minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources, and wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work. "Unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labour in vain" applies very much to the restoration of the Cathedral Nave.




