PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Pray for global peace and stability in the midst of political tensions and the war in Ukraine. Russia has installed leaders in four Ukrainian regions it has occupied and plans on including these areas as part of the Russian Federation. Ukraine and the West consider these areas to be illegally occupied. Pray against an escalation of the war and against the use of nuclear weapons by Russia if Ukraine attempts to take back these occupied territories.

SINGAPORE

Pray for our government as they continue to watch over our nation, work with Singaporeans to review and refresh Singapore's social compact and set out a roadmap for the next decade and beyond. Pray also for Singapore's relationship with India to be strengthened as both countries explore ways to further economic cooperation in new areas such as food and energy security, green technology and digital connectivity.

DIOCESE

Anglican Schools

Pray for the principals & senior leadership in our Anglican schools, that they may have wisdom and courage to lead their teams in fulfilling the education mission; for the well-being of teachers and support staff as they labour tirelessly in their roles and responsibilities; for the chaplaincy teams to effectively minister among students and staff and for open doors of opportunity to share the gospel; for the students to have emotional and mental health, to grow in wisdom in their academic pursuit and to become positive, resilient servant leaders in their generation.

Deanery of Laos

Praise God for the new leadership teams (i) Revd Ian and Sue Jennings for the Church of the Holy Spirit in Vientiane and (ii) Revd Ian Dierden and Mr Danny Longkumer for the Anglican Relief and Development Agency (ARDA). Pray for them as they work with others and with each other. Praise God also for a reduction in COVID-19 restrictions which has enabled more students to return to language classes. Pray for the nation of Laos which is still experiencing financial crises including high inflation and a large devaluation in currency.

Due to the F1 Singapore Grand Prix, the following services will be cancelled:



We continue to praise and thank God for the consistent number of workers on the site. Most of the workers are now deployed externally. The plaster removal at the North side is nearing completion. We can expect similar works to continue on the South side next week. Bricks surface preparations have commenced at the East and North

sides, where the plaster has been removed. The consultants will carry out inspections to these areas before giving the go ahead for plastering works to proceed.

We seek prayers for the availability of all materials needed for the ongoing works and that any "hold ups" that are causing the delay in the delivery will be resolved at the soonest possible time.

The external scaffolding at the South side is now connected to the East side. We now have scaffolds all around the Main building, except for the bell tower. The erection of the scaffold at the bell tower will commence this week and is expected to take two full months to complete. More scaffolding works will also take place at the internal of the main building (Nave area) as well as extending upwards the existing external scaffolds to wrap around the spires at the transepts. This will take place in September.

Works inside the Nave have been slow as the workers are presently deployed externally. They are redeployed to carry out internal works only during wet weather. Removal of plaster at the columns at West Porch are near completion. Biocide treatment as well as salt treatment will take place at these areas within the week.

Please continue to pray for God's favour over the restoration – for skilled workers to be available, a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue, minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources, and wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work. "Unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labour in vain" applies very much to the restoration of the Cathedral Nave.





