## THE WORLD

The 27th Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP 27) will be held in Egypt from 6-18 November. ## I WAS FEELING AIMLESS AT WORK AND PONDERED THE MEANING OF LIFE.

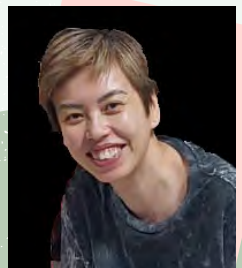
So when I saw the publicity for **JOURNEY OF PURPOSE**, I signed up to attend the Q&A session to find out more.

*Lord, You are God. You created the heavens and earth and put everything in place. You made the world to be lived in, not to be a place of empty chaos. You are our Lord and there is no other. Thank You, Father, for being a wall of fire and protection around our congregations, families and those involved in the restoration of our Cathedral Nave building. We seek for God's Kingdom to come and God's will to be done on earth as it is in heaven, for the Cathedral Nave restoration project. We know that You will make our thoughts agreeable to Your will, so that the plans for this project may be established and succeed.*

*We continue to Praise and Thank You, Father in Heaven, for the progress that has been made in the past weeks. We thank You for blessing us with a steady stream of competent general workers and skilled labourers, who through their weathered hands and perspired foreheads, show their dedication to the work involved. We have commenced plastering works at the East Side. Plastering works to the North Side will commence next week. Bricks surface preparations towards the West Porch are in progress and it will be followed shortly by the plastering works. We continue to seek You, Lord, for the availability of all materials needed for the ongoing works.*

*The erection of the scaffold at the bell tower is now at its  $\frac{3}{4}$  mark. It should reach the top within the next 2 weeks. We pray, Lord, for the safety of the scaffolders as they complete the scaffolding to the bell tower. Scaffolding works will commence inside the Nave in October.*

Protect them, Lord, from the evils of rushing, complacency, and distraction that may cause unnecessary injuries. Give them the ability to know the dangers before them, and the alertness and skills to avoid them.*

*We continue to pray for Your favour Lord, over the restoration – for skilled workers to be available, for a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue with minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources, and wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work. “Unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labour in vain” applies very much to the restoration of the Cathedral Nave.*

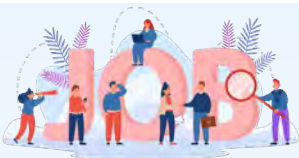
