Sharing the Love of Christ with the workers during this Christmas Season.

Progress has been slow in December. The workers need materials that have yet to arrive, such as lime plaster. We are in discussion with the various suppliers and the main contractor, and we hope to resolve the delay in the supply of materials soon. The workers affected by the shortage of materials are presently working at the bell tower.

There are 32 levels to the bell tower. The workers have completed 90% of the paint removal from Levels 12 to 32, and have removed all the hollow sections of plaster found at these levels. Initial investigations carried out by the Cathedral's technical team after the removal of the hollow sections indicated that almost all the cement plasters found at Levels 18 to 24 may need to be removed. A closer study of these areas will be carried out in the first week of January 2023 to confirm the initial findings. If the initial findings are correct, we can expect a delay in the removal of the bell tower scaffolding that was earlier scheduled for end January 2023.

Please continue to pray for the smooth supply of lime plaster materials, the scaffold materials needed for the remaining parts of the Nave, the safety of all workers and the technical team, especially when working at heights and for good weather, so that all works can continue smoothly and safely.

We continue to Praise and Thank God for

the progress we have made thus far in the other areas. The sub-contractor for the reinforced concrete works to the trenches will commence works in January, and we have acquired the services of a painting sub-contractor. Once we have the lime plaster materials to apply onto the "repaired" walls, after the completion of the final skim coat to the external walls, painting to these walls will commence shortly.

We wish to thank our members, from both the English and the Mandarin congregations, who have stepped forward to share the Love of Christ with the workers over the Christmas season. Working together with the SAC Missions team, the workers were given a backpack filled with necessities and goodies, a sumptuous Nasi Briyani Lunch and a Love gift. The joy expressed by the workers, as seen from their faces and appreciation shown were indeed a testimony of God's Love and Hope. We Praise and Thank God.

We continue to pray for Your favour Lord, over the restoration – for skilled workers to be available, for a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue with minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources, and wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work. *"Unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labour in vain"* applies very much to the restoration of the Cathedral Nave. In Jesus Name, we pray. Amen.
