PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS



THE WORLD

On 6 Feb, a magnitude 7.8 earthquake killed thousands of people across a broad strip of Turkey and northwest Syria. It is the worst earthquake to hit Turkey since 1939. It levelled entire apartment blocks in Turkish cities and caused more devastation to millions of Syrians displaced by years of war. The initial quake was followed by dozens of aftershocks and more aftershocks are expected in the next few weeks or even months, potentially leading to more deaths. Pray that the injured will receive timely medical attention; survivors will recover from the trauma, the homeless will be housed and be provided with clean water, food and supplies. Pray that those who lost loved ones will be comforted and for all necessary measures to be taken to prevent further loss of lives. Pray that amid the uncertainties of life, the people will find hope and security in Christ.

SINGAPORE

Pray for good international relations between our government and world leaders and for bilateral ties between Singapore and Vietnam to be further strengthened particularly in the digital and green economy. Pray that our government and its agencies will remain vigilant to the threat of radicalisation and keep Singapore safe from terror attacks.

DIOCESE

Church of Our Savior

Pray for Archdeacon Daniel Wee who is overseeing St John's-St Margaret's Church and

Church of Our Savior as Vicar; for the Alpha courses starting in both English and Chinese congregations. Pray for a good follow up and discipleship programme for new believers and for the upcoming youth internship in the youth ministry. Works on the underground trenches (which will carry the electrical wiring and air-conditioning ducts for the Nave) began in late December 2022. Almost 90% of the trenches are presently cast in concrete. We hope to complete the concrete works on the trenches by the end of January 2023. With this, the M&E contractors will be able to commence work in February, to lay the trunking needed for the Electrical, AV, IT and Air-conditioning works.

Some of the materials needed (e.g., lime plaster) have yet to arrive. Discussions are still ongoing with the suppliers and the contractor, and we hope to quickly resolve all outstanding issues so that the works can move forward smoothly.

A closer study of the external walls of the bell tower was carried out during the first week of January 2023. Cement plaster was found between levels 16 to 24, and a thin layer of cement skim coat on the other levels. These layers of cement plaster will need to be removed before the re-plastering with lime plaster can take place.

Removal of plaster and brick repair works on the internal walls and at West Porch are still

ongoing but with fewer workers, as most of the workers are deployed externally to try to finish all external works as quickly as possible.

Painting will soon commence at levels 2 and 3 internally at South Transept.

We seek your continuing prayers for the smooth supply of lime plaster materials and the scaffold materials needed for the remaining parts of the Nave, for the safety of all workers and the technical team, especially when working at heights, and for good weather, so as all works can continue smoothly and safely.

With Chinese New Year in January, we want to thank members, both from the English and the Mandarin congregations, who have stepped forward to share Christ's love with the workers. Again, together with the SAC Missions Team, the workers were given their favourite Nasi Briyani Lunch and Love gifts. We Praise and Thank God for these beautiful moments where we can share His Love and Joy with the workers.

We continue to pray for Your favour Lord, over the restoration – for skilled workers to be available, for a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue with minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources, and wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work. *“Unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labour in vain”* applies very much to the restoration of the Cathedral Nave. In Jesus Name, we pray. Amen.
