PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

The combined death toll from the massive earthquake in Turkey and Syria has exceeded 41,000 and about 26 million homeless survivors across both countries are in urgent need of humanitarian assistance. There are also growing concerns over the spread of infectious diseases arising from poor hygiene and sanitation. Pray for good coordination and collaboration among international aid organizations and for safe access routes to be opened for a steady stream of essential supplies to reach survivors in badly hit, difficult to access as well as rebel-controlled parts of Syria. Pray also for sufficient medical facilities to treat the physically injured and children who are suffering post-traumatic stress disorder from the aftermath of the quake.

SINGAPORE

Thank God for a proactive and caring government which constantly strives to better the lives of Singaporeans and create a Singapore where future generations can continue to thrive and flourish. Pray that Singapore will remain a united and strong nation where different races and cultures can integrate our diversities and channel them towards common aspirations and goals.

DIOCESE

St James' Church

Pray that St James' Church may grow to be a community that loves and serves one another. Pray that it will be a church where authentic spiritual friendships develop, people with special needs feel they belong, and where members engage in community with their distinctive gifts. Pray for their upcoming Alpha Course (15 Feb-29 Apr) that many will experience the love and goodness of God. Pray also for the preschool

chaplaincy to powerfully minister to the students, teachers and families of students from St James' Church Kindergarten in the Leedon & Gilstead campuses.

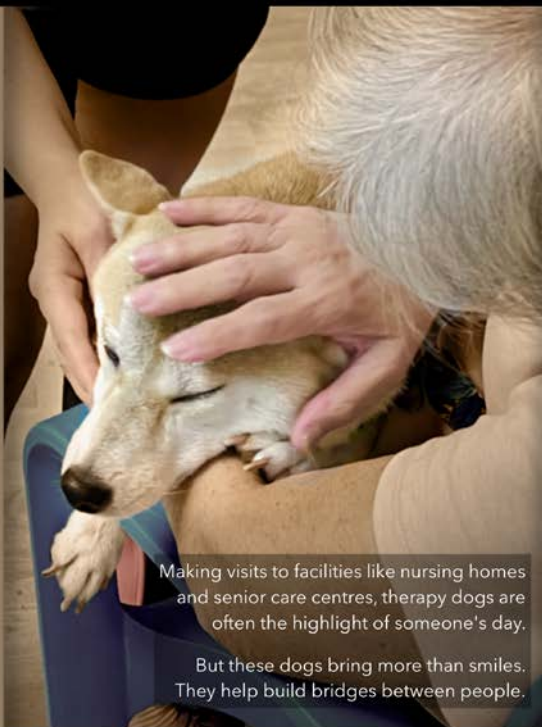

Works on the underground trenches (which will carry the electrical wiring and air-conditioning ducts for the Nave) began in late December 2022. Almost 90% of the trenches are presently cast in concrete. We hope to complete the concrete works on the trenches by the end of January 2023. With this, the M&E contractors will be able to commence work in February, to lay the trunking needed for the Electrical, AV, IT and Air-conditioning works.

Some of the materials needed (e.g., lime plaster) have yet to arrive. Discussions are still ongoing with the suppliers and the contractor, and we hope to quickly resolve all outstanding issues so that the works can move forward smoothly.

A closer study of the external walls of the bell tower was carried out during the first week of January 2023. Cement plaster was found between levels 16 to 24, and a thin layer of cement skim coat on the other levels. These layers of cement plaster will need to be removed before the re-plastering with lime plaster can take place.

Removal of plaster and brick repair works on the internal walls and at West Porch are still

ongoing but with fewer workers, as most of the workers are deployed externally to try to finish all external works as quickly as possible.

Painting will soon commence at levels 2 and 3 internally at South Transept.

We seek your continuing prayers for the smooth supply of lime plaster materials and the scaffold materials needed for the remaining parts of the Nave, for the safety of all workers and the technical team, especially when working at heights, and for good weather, so as all works can continue smoothly and safely.

With Chinese New Year in January, we want to thank members, both from the English and the Mandarin congregations, who have stepped forward to share Christ's love with the workers. Again, together with the SAC Missions Team, the workers were given their favourite Nasi Briyani Lunch and Love gifts. We Praise and Thank God for these beautiful moments where we can share His Love and Joy with the workers.

We continue to pray for Your favour Lord, over the restoration – for skilled workers to be available, for a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue with minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources, and wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work. “*Unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labour in vain*” applies very much to the restoration of the Cathedral Nave. In Jesus Name, we pray. Amen.
