# PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

## **THE WORLD**

Notice is hereby given that the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Parish of St Andrew's Cathedral will be held on 23 April 2023 (Sunday) at 2pm at the Cathedral New Sanctuary (CNS).

## **ELECTORAL ROLL**

Members who wish to vote at the AGM must be on the Electoral Roll (ER) of St Andrew's Cathedral. Baptised members who are at least 17 years of age, confirmed in the Anglican Church, regularly attending Service and partaking Holy Communion in the Cathedral, are eligible to be on the Electoral Roll. Members may check if you are on the Electoral Roll by submitting the ER Enquiry Form, and update your particulars by submitting the Membership Update Form.

The Electoral Roll membership for the purposes of AGM 2023 shall be the prevailing enrolled members on the Electoral Roll at the date of the AGM. If you are not on the Electoral Roll but are eligible, please submit your ER Application Form (available by request from [membership@cathedral.org.sg](mailto:membership@cathedral.org.sg)) before 11:59am on 16 April 2023 (Sunday) if you wish to be eligible to vote at the AGM 2023.

## **AGM ATTENDANCE**

The quorum for the AGM may be formed only by members on the Electoral Roll who are physically present at the AGM. Members are encouraged to pre-register their attendance at the AGM by submitting the AGM 2023 Registration Form before 11:59am on 20 April 2023 (Thursday), to facilitate faster registration and entry into the AGM.

## **ANNUAL REPORT, FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND BUDGET**

Members may download the Annual Report directly from the Cathedral website.

Members who are on the Electoral Roll may request to receive soft copies of the Financial Statements and Budget by submitting the AGM 2023 Registration Form before 11:59am on 20 April 2023 (Thursday), to receive the documents before the AGM. Please note that we are going paperless as much as possible for a better environment, and hard copies of the documents will not be generally available.

## **NOMINATIONS FOR ELECTION TO THE PAROCHIAL CHURCH COUNCIL**

The AGM will elect the People's Warden, 12 members of the Parochial Church Council (PCC) and 04 Synod Representatives.

According to the St Andrew's Cathedral Constitution, candidates for election to membership of the Parochial Church Council shall be on the Electoral Roll of the Parish and must be nominated by writing from one member and seconded by another to the Honorary Secretary at least 08 days prior to the AGM subject to prior written consent to nomination by the candidate. The Candidate, Proposer and Secunder must all be members on the Cathedral Electoral Roll.

PCC Nomination Forms are available from the Cathedral website and at the Cathedral

Welcome Centre. The nomination forms shall be submitted by electronic means, or by hand/post to Secretariat, St Andrew's Cathedral, 11 St Andrew's Road, Singapore 178959, before 11:59am on 08 April 2023 (Saturday).

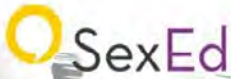

We praise and thank God for the arrival of the lime plaster materials. The removal of plaster and brick repair works at the Bell Tower is nearing completion, and plastering works to the repaired wall surfaces using the lime plaster will now take place in the coming weeks. Priority will be given to the Bell Tower as we hope to finish the works to the Bell Tower in the earliest possible time. A small team of plasterers will concurrently work on the external walls of the Transepts where the walls are ready to be plastered and painted. Removal of plaster and brick repair works at the West Porch is nearing completion, and we hope to have additional plasterers coming onsite in the coming weeks to work on the completed areas. Painting works to the offices on Levels 2 and 3 of the South Transept should be completed soon, after which the painters will move on to paint the external areas where the walls are plastered and ready.

We are also looking into the rainwater discharge system at the Bell Tower. Whenever there is heavy rainfall, the rainwater overflows into the belfry and into the ringing chamber. We hope to address the issue by creating more discharge outlets at the belfry level, where the rainwater is collected and dispersed through the existing discharge system. We hope to increase the flow rate of the discharge water, as well as minimise the collection of rainwater at the four corners of the Bell Tower.

Within the Nave, the trenches are ready and the M&E works are in progress. The air-conditioning pipes are presently being laid. Once completed, the electrical works will commence together with the laying of cables for the AV and IT systems.

The Cathedral team continues to work closely with the main contractor on site operation matters. As we work towards the completion of the restoration project, we continue to pray for the timely provision of the scaffold materials

needed for the rest of the Nave; for the safety of all workers and the technical team, especially when working at heights; and for good weather, so as all works can continue smoothly and safely.

We also continue to pray for the Lord's favour over the restoration: for skilled workers to be available; for a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue with minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources; and for wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work.

*"Unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labour in vain"* applies very much to the restoration of the Cathedral Nave. In Jesus Name, we pray. Amen.
