Notice is hereby given that the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Parish of St Andrew's Cathedral will be held on 23 April 2023 (Sunday) at 2pm at the Cathedral New Sanctuary (CNS).

ELECTORAL ROLL

Members who wish to vote at the AGM must be on the Electoral Roll (ER) of St Andrew's Cathedral. Baptised members who are at least 17 years of age, confirmed in the Anglican Church, regularly attending Service and partaking Holy Communion in the Cathedral, are eligible to be on the Electoral Roll. Members may check if you are on the Electoral Roll by submitting the ER Enquiry Form, and update your particulars by submitting the Membership Update Form.

The Electoral Roll membership for the purposes of AGM 2023 shall be the prevailing enrolled members on the Electoral Roll at the date of the AGM. If you are not on the Electoral Roll but are eligible, please submit your ER Application Form (available by request from membership@cathedral.org.sg) before 11:59am on 16 April 2023 (Sunday) if you wish to be eligible to vote at the AGM 2023.

AGM ATTENDANCE

The quorum for the AGM may be formed only by members on the Electoral Roll who are physically present at the AGM. Members are encouraged to pre-register their attendance at the AGM by submitting the AGM 2023 Registration Form before 11:59am on 20 April 2023 (Thursday), to facilitate faster registration and entry into the AGM.

ANNUAL REPORT, FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND BUDGET

Members may download the Annual Report directly from the Cathedral website.

Members who are on the Electoral Roll may request to receive soft copies of the Financial Statements and Budget by submitting the AGM 2023 Registration Form before 11:59am on 20 April 2023 (Thursday), to receive the documents before the AGM. Please note that we are going paperless as much as possible for a better environment, and hard copies of the documents will not be generally available.

NOMINATIONS FOR ELECTION TO THE PAROCHIAL CHURCH COUNCIL

The AGM will elect the People's Warden, 12 members of the Parochial Church Council (PCC) and 04 Synod Representatives.

According to the St Andrew's Cathedral Constitution, candidates for election to membership of the Parochial Church Council shall be on the Electoral Roll of the Parish and must be nominated by writing from one member and seconded by another to the Honorary Secretary at least 08 days prior to the AGM subject to prior written consent to nomination by the candidate. The Candidate, Proposer and Secunder must all be members on the Cathedral Electoral Roll.

THE WELCOME CENTRE

“See, I have set before you an open door that no one can shut.”

Revelation 3:8

We are thankful to God for blessing the Cathedral with the Welcome Centre – a special space set apart to be His open door for all to enter to encounter Him. By God’s grace, He brings us together as the church to work out His purpose for it. By faith, we look to Him to lead us on.

Based on the study undertaken by a Taskforce in 2021 on the use of the Welcome Centre in the post-Covid season, the PCC had considered members’ feedback received, the financial position, the functional and ministry aims of the Welcome Centre. A resolution was then passed to cease the commercial operations of the Cathedral Cafe. Subsequently, a working committee was commissioned last year to prepare for the Welcome Centre reopening.

Being an integral part of the Cathedral, the Welcome Centre’s purpose and use are decidedly aligned with the Cathedral’s focus on discipleship and evangelism, and with the Diocesan’s call to obey the Great Commandment (Matt. 22:36-40) and to fulfill the Great Commission (Matt.28:16-20). We envision the Welcome Centre to be a place of blessing to both the public and members – an oasis offering rest and respite from the activities, cares and busyness of life and work. Those who enter are welcomed with warm hospitality and a friendly chat or listening ear

over a complimentary cup of coffee/tea in a comfortable setting. For those with pastoral needs, attentive care is extended and the follow-up by specific ministries to help with such needs.

It is our heartfelt prayer that our Lord Jesus will draw many to encounter him with the spirit refreshed, the soul restored, the heart encouraged with hope through fellowship, and lives saved through the sharing of the good news. May it be a space where the Cathedral family can come together to share life to bless each other, and to serve to bless the community.

With several major renovations in progress on the Cathedral ground, there is a significant limitation of space. Consequently, the Welcome Centre is now used as staff workspace, a place for meetings and ministry. The eventual reopening of the Welcome Centre is closely dependent on the completion of these renovations. We hope to share more updates along the way as the work progresses.

“Unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labour in vain.”

We continue to Thank God for answered prayers: the second delivery of lime plaster materials has arrived; the second half of scaffolding work from the main Nave to the reredos is in progress and nearing completion; the plastering work to the bell tower is progressing well; the laying of air-conditioning pipes is almost done and the pressure tests have been conducted; the electrical contractor has started laying the containments which will be followed by the laying of cables for the various services, such as IT, AV system, CCTV and other security systems; the painting of the staff offices at the South Transept L2 and L3 has been completed, and the cleaning of these offices and minor repair work to the window and door glass panels is in progress; and the painting of the external walls at the South Transept has been completed.

We are currently looking at the completion of all works to the external walls of the bell tower by May 2023, after which the scaffolding around the bell tower will be dismantled. The repair works to the fleur-de-lis (located at the bell tower) will commence soon, and hopefully, will be completed before the scaffolding is removed. The main contractor plans to complete the rest of the external works in stages, and to reassign the workers to carry out internal works as each stage of external works is completed. The SAC team will continue to work closely with the main contractor on site operation matters.

We are thankful for members from the Mandarin and English congregations who have continued to bless the workers with meals and love gifts. Such sharing of God’s love and care has touched the workers, who are very appreciative.

In the recent weeks, we have been informed by the main contractor for the Cathedral Nave Restoration project, Shanghai Chong Kee Furniture & Construction Pte Ltd (“SCK”), that they had on 20 March 2023, applied to the High Court of the Republic of Singapore for moratorium protection. In the application to court, SCK has sought court orders to restrain legal actions by creditors for a period of 6 months. If the application is granted, the court-supervised process will give time for SCK to reorganise its liabilities and business, including holding discussions with potential investors and potential asset divestments. SCK has further

informed us that they remain committed to continue and to complete the ongoing project.

In the meantime, the Cathedral leadership is seeking legal advice on the implications of the Moratorium Application on Cathedral and the Nave Restoration project, and working through with our consultants and project team on the best way to move the project forward to ensure the timely completion. We will continue to update members from time to time on significant events affecting the project.

We continue to pray for the Lord’s favour over the restoration –

- for smooth work progress and the safety of all workers and the technical team, especially when working at heights;
- for good weather, so that the works can continue smoothly and safely;
- for skilled workers to be available;
- for a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue with minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources; and
- for wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work.

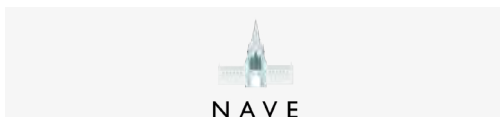

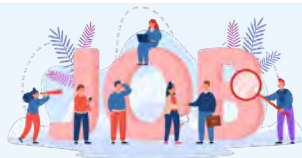
