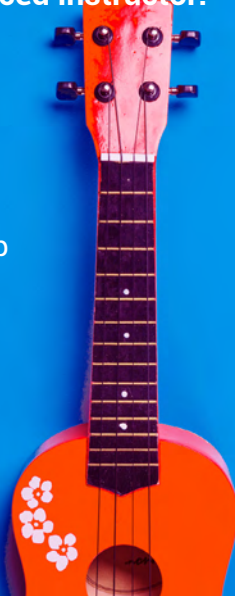

When you next visit the Cathedral, do look up at the bell tower.

- The workers have started removing the scaffolds at the spire, revealing a cross at the top and the St Andrew's Cross just below it. It is a beautiful sight, which we've not seen for almost 6 months.
- There are 32 levels from ground level to the top of the tower, at a height of 64 metres. Several inspections were carried out earlier to ensure that the repairs were in good order, before the go ahead was given for the removal of the scaffolds down to the 18th level.
- Works are ongoing to restore or replace the "fleur de lis" finial at the 18th level. Once that work is completed, the scaffold at the bell tower will be removed, starting from end July onwards.

Our good Lord continues to see us through as we work towards the completion of the restoration works. We continue to raise our hands unto Our Father in Heaven in thanksgiving and praise.

We continue to see good progress to the following:

1. Internal works:

- Plaster and brick repairs in the main section of the Cathedral have been completed. Plastering works will commence soon, to be followed by painting to the walls and columns.
- Laying of electrical cables inside the trench is almost done; AV cabling works inside the trench is also almost done. The works to cover the trench are expected to commence in June, after all the services cabling and AC pipes have been laid.
- New scaffolds are now being erected along the aisles in the Nave, in preparation for the removal of hollow plasters and brick repairs.
- Repairs to the glass windows and doors at North Transept have been completed, and the workers have started on the glass windows and doors at the South Transept.

2. Bell Tower:

- Plastering and painting works are ongoing from Level 18 and below.
- Repairs to the fleur de lis are in progress.
- Waterproofing works to the "balconies" at the bell tower will take place as the scaffolds are removed.
- We expect the works to the bell tower to be completed by July.

3. External Works:

- Works at the steeples along the South Transept will continue, and the washing of the roof of the Nave has been scheduled for end of June.

We continue to pray for the Lord's favour over the restoration –

- for smooth work progress and the safety of all workers and the technical team, especially when working at heights;
- for good weather, so that the works can continue smoothly and safely;
- for skilled workers to be available;
- for a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue with minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources; and
- for wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work.

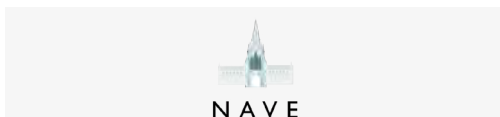
