

THE WORLD

Asia remains in the grip of a blistering heatwave and climate scientists predict that 2023 could be the world's hottest year. Pray that governments in the region will be able to put in action plans to deal with the consequences to their peoples - to protect public health, deal with resulting drought, haze, and further disruptions to economies still recovering from the damage done by the pandemic years.

SINGAPORE

Phishing activities, increasing sophistication in malware scams and the stealing of banking credentials have recently increased. Pray for the Singapore Police Force to have the tools and the trained manpower to speedily track down and prosecute criminals.

More and more transactions migrate to online platforms that enable us to invest, shop, order food, arrange deliveries and travel from the convenience of our phones. Pray for effective public outreach programmes on good cyber hygiene practices and that users take responsibility to be educated, on the safe use of applications and its dangers.

Pray that the Cyber Security Agency of Singapore be equipped to perform its critical function of setting up a strong foundation of cyber security to fend off the multitude of threats that lurk in cyberspace; that we employ people of integrity and ability to build effective cyber defences and that the Agency stays on top of the rapid developments taking place in cyberspace.

JULY 2023 UPDATE ON NAVE RESTORATION WORKS

ost of the works in June were concentrated at the Choir Stall and the Sanctuary. We hope to complete the plastering of the walls by mid-July and have the scaffolds removed after that. There are large areas on many of the walls inside the Nave that need plastering. The plan is to carry out the plastering work in different stages, starting from the Choir Stall and moving towards the West Porch, and removing the scaffolds along the main Nave as we progress on. This will then pave the way for the installation of the air-con fan coil units (FCUs) and the AV and electrical fittings, as well as flooring works. The M&E works are progressing well. The trunkings for the cables and pipes are mostly covered, and casting works to cover the M&E trenches will commence from the last week of June.

We also continue to see good progress to the following:

1. Internal works:

- Application of lime plaster base coats are ongoing to walls and columns at the Choir Stall and the Sanctuary, and the finishing skim coats are being applied after the base coats "cure".
- The scaffold installation along the south aisle has been completed, and the brick and plaster repairs to the area are nearing completion. The installation of scaffold along the north aisle is ongoing, and will be followed by brick and plaster repair works.
- Carpentry and glass investigative works have commenced at the Sacristy and the Vestry.

2. Bell Tower:

- Plastering and painting works are ongoing from Level 18 and below.
- Repairs to the fleur-de-lis are in progress. We have a new wooden carving of the shape of the fleur-de-lis to replace the old rotten wood. The new wooden carving is now being carefully wrapped with lead, after which the lead will be coated with lead patination oil and reinstalled at the 18th level.
- Waterproofing works to the "balconies" at the bell tower will take place in stages, commencing in July.

3. External Works:

 Spires above the South Transept: The spire closer to the West Lawn has been painted, and some minor repair works will be carried out to the pre-cast structure of this spire. Similar repairs will be

- carried out to the second spire before the spire is painted.
- Spires above the Sacristy: Inspection to these spires were carried out last week, when we found that the surface is lime plaster. Minor repairs to the surface will be carried out. The fleur-de-lis at the top of the spires is in very good condition, and no repairs will be required to them.
- A trial wash of the roof slates was carried out to a small area of the South Transept roof, to trial the various washing methods to ensure minimal or no damage to the roof slates.

We continue to pray for the Lord's favour over the restoration –

- for smooth work progress and the safety of all workers and the technical team, especially when working at heights;
- for good weather, so that the works can continue smoothly and safely;
- for skilled workers to be available:
- for a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue with minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources; and
- for wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work.


