PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Global expectations and support for the transition to a multi-polar world have raised the spectre of more wars being initiated by belligerent powers to maintain the status quo. Pray for the wisdom and efforts of peace seeking leaders to prevail. Pray for deception and lies whether from government leaders or the media to be quickly exposed.

Pray that ASEAN will be successful in maintaining peaceful and collaborative co-existence among all its members. Pray for the conditions that will allow the gospel to go out into all the world and for God's faithful people worldwide to pray, give, send and get the good news out to the nations.

As the world continues to experience the effects of extreme climate conditions, pray that governments will be able to take prompt measures to minimise the debilitating and destructive consequences to their people.

SINGAPORE

There are plans to help and train job seekers in new industries and economic activities. Pray that these will be effectively executed so that Singaporeans can overcome the hurdles that prevent them from finding gainful employment. Pray for improved contract terms for those in the gig economy that will enable them to earn a fair wage.

DIOCESE

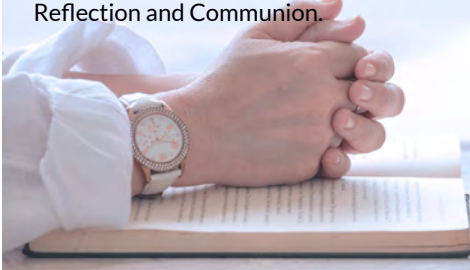

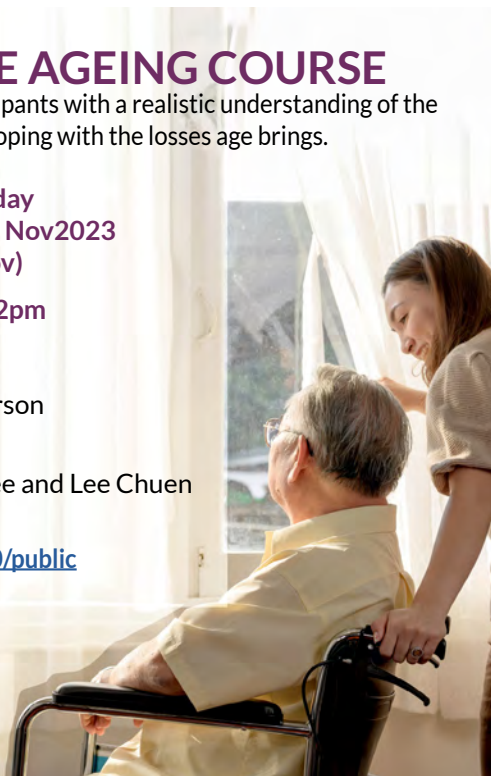

Most of the works in June were concentrated at the Choir Stall and the Sanctuary. We hope to complete the plastering of the walls by mid-July and have the scaffolds removed after that. There are large areas on many of the walls inside the Nave that need plastering. The plan is to carry out the plastering work in different stages, starting from the Choir Stall and moving towards the West Porch, and removing the scaffolds along the main Nave as we progress on. This will then pave the way for the installation of the air-con fan coil units (FCUs) and the AV and electrical fittings, as well as flooring works. The M&E works are progressing well. The trunkings for the cables and pipes are mostly covered, and casting works to cover the M&E trenches will commence from the last week of June.

We also continue to see good progress to the following:

1. Internal works:

- Application of lime plaster base coats are ongoing to walls and columns at the Choir Stall and the Sanctuary, and the finishing skim coats are being applied after the base coats “cure”.
- The scaffold installation along the south aisle has been completed, and the brick and plaster repairs to the area are nearing completion. The installation of scaffold along the north aisle is ongoing, and will be followed by brick and plaster repair works.
- Carpentry and glass investigative works have commenced at the Sacristy and the Vestry.

2. Bell Tower:

- Plastering and painting works are ongoing from Level 18 and below.
- Repairs to the fleur-de-lis are in progress. We have a new wooden carving of the shape of the fleur-de-lis to replace the old rotten wood. The new wooden carving is now being carefully wrapped with lead, after which the lead will be coated with lead patination oil and reinstalled at the 18th level.
- Waterproofing works to the “balconies” at the bell tower will take place in stages, commencing in July.

3. External Works:

- Spires above the South Transept: The spire closer to the West Lawn has been painted, and some minor repair works will be carried out to the pre-cast structure of this spire. Similar repairs will be carried out to the second spire before the spire is painted.
- Spires above the Sacristy: Inspection to these spires were carried out last week, when we found that the surface is lime plaster. Minor repairs to the surface will be carried out. The fleur-de-lis at the top of the spires is in very good condition, and no repairs will be required to them.
- A trial wash of the roof slates was carried out to a small area of the South Transept roof, to trial the various washing methods to ensure minimal or no damage to the roof slates.

We continue to pray for the Lord’s favour over the restoration –

- for smooth work progress and the safety of all workers and the technical team, especially when working at heights;
- for good weather, so that the works can continue smoothly and safely;
- for skilled workers to be available;
- for a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue with minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources; and
- for wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work.

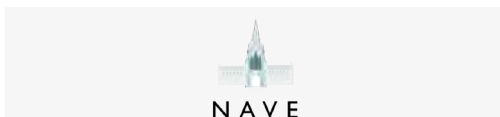

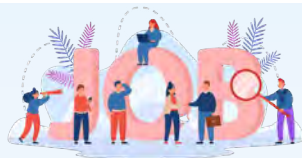
