THE WORLD

Several typhoons and tropical storms have resulted in the loss of lives, landslides and severe damage to property and infrastructure in Hong Kong, Southern China and Japan. It threatens agriculture, and may lead to food shortage and inflation. Pray for swift and adequate resources to conduct rescue work, clean-up, repair and return to normalcy. Pray also for the rescue work that is ongoing in Morocco which experienced a strong earthquake last week and that lives will be saved.

SINGAPORE

The Health Sciences Authority has reported that vaping is on the rise in Singapore and it appears to be gaining popularity among younger smokers. Pray for wisdom on all the relevant Singapore agencies for effective enforcement to stop availability. Pray that young people will realise the health risks and that they can throw off the habit before it leads to more dangerous forms of addiction.

Anglican Preschool Services













Diocesan Education Month: Anglican Preschool Services (APS)

APS was set up by the Anglican Diocese of Singapore to be a bridge between the Church and community through holistic preschool education, infused with Christian values. To date, APS operates 18 Christian preschools, sowing seeds & transforming lives. You can support APS by (a) enrolling your child in an APS preschool;

- (b) signing up as a staff or volunteer;
- (c) praying for APS; and
- (d) giving financially.

Responding to the demand childcare, APS needs to convert all its kindergartens to childcare centres. The conversion will cost \$5.9M over two years. About 45% of this has been secured, leaving about \$3M yet to be raised. Do prayerfully consider partnering APS in this conversion endeavour. AUGUST 2023 UPDATE ON NAVE RESTORATION WORKS

The contractors have nearly completed the plastering works inside the Nave, leaving small areas in the Vestry and Sacristy. 2 coats of paint have been applied to the South Side of the Nave, leaving the final coat to be applied as the scaffolds are dismantled in September.

Painting works to the lower section of the Bell Tower and the North Side of the Nave are inprogress. The scaffolds at these areas are scheduled to be dismantled by the end of September. The installation and making good of the lightning protection system at the Bell Tower has been completed. The plastering works to the lower half of the Bell Tower (from Level 8 down) are progressing well.

There has been a slight delay to the trench casting works in the Nave, which should now commence in the first week of September.



2 coats of paint have been applied on the walls at the South Side of Nave.

We continue to see good progress to the following:

1. Internal works:

- Painting works are ongoing at the North Side.
 Plastering works are ongoing at the spiral stairs walls.
- The M&E contractors are readying the pipes and cables for works to the columns in the Nave, and installation of equipment will take place as soon as the scaffolds are removed.

2. Bell Tower:

- Plastering and painting works are ongoing at the lower levels.
- The coloured glass for the Bell Tower windows have been cut to different shapes and are waiting to be installed before the scaffolds come down.

3. External Works:

 The contractor has commenced the washing of the roof slates, which will take about 4-6 weeks.

We continue to pray for the Lord's favour over the restoration –

- for the safety of all workers and the technical team, especially when working at heights;
- for clear weather, so that the works can continue smoothly and safely;
- for skilled workers to be available;
- for a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue with minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources:
- for wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work; and
- for smooth work progress and the speedy completion of the Nave restoration project.


