PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS,

THE WORLD

Residents and rescue workers are struggling to cope with the thousands of corpses washing up or decaying under rubble after a sudden catastrophic flood in Libya smashed down buildings and swept people out to sea. Thousands were kiiled and thousands more missing. [CNA 15 Sep]

Pray for help to reach them swiftly – priority areas are shelter, food, clean water, and key primary medical care because of waterborne diseases and the lack of clean water.

Pray also for the survivors of the recent Morocco earthquake as they mourn their loss and rebuild their lives.

SINGAPORE

A resurgence of DenV-1 dengue virus strain is worrying the National Environment Agency as the drop in population immunity could be sufficient for dengue cases to surge again. [ST 17 Sep]

Pray for effective methods to control the risks of infections and for quick and full recovery for those who succumb to the disease.

Pray for our hospitals and clinics, the doctors and staff as they remain vigilant to attend to the sick.

DIOCESE

September is set aside the Diocesan Education month.

Pray for Anglican Preschool Services (APS) - that Christian teachers and staff will join our

preschool ministry and that God will continue to impart wisdom and guidance to the leaders in our Anglican preschools, to navigate the evolving early childhood education landscape. Pray that God will grow our children into their God-given identity and their families will come to know the love of God through our preschools. Pray that believers will recognise the importance of Christian preschools, and that God will supply all that is required for the development of excellent preschools in Singapore. To meet the demand for more childcare centres, pray that funds will also be quickly available to enable us to meet this need.


Nave Restoration

Diocesan Education Month: Anglican Preschool Services (APS)

APS was set up by the Anglican Diocese of Singapore to be a bridge between the Church and community through holistic preschool education, infused with Christian values. To date, APS operates 18 Christian preschools, sowing seeds & transforming lives. You can support APS by

(a) enrolling your child in an APS preschool;

- (b) signing up as a staff or volunteer;
- (c) praving for APS; and
- (d) giving financially.

Responding to the demand for childcare, APS needs to convert all its kindergartens to childcare centres. The conversion will cost \$5.9M over two years. About 45% of this has been secured, leaving about \$3M yet to be raised. Do prayerfully consider partnering APS in this conversion endeavour. AUGUST 2023 UPDATE ON NAVE RESTORATION WORKS

The contractors have nearly completed the plastering works inside the Nave, leaving small areas in the Vestry and Sacristy. 2 coats of paint have been applied to the South Side of the Nave, leaving the final coat to be applied as the scaffolds are dismantled in September.

Painting works to the lower section of the Bell Tower and the North Side of the Nave are inprogress. The scaffolds at these areas are scheduled to be dismantled by the end of September. The installation and making good of the lightning protection system at the Bell Tower has been completed. The plastering works to the lower half of the Bell Tower (from Level 8 down) are progressing well.

There has been a slight delay to the trench casting works in the Nave, which should now commence in the first week of September.



2 coats of paint have been applied on the walls at the South Side of Nave.

We continue to see good progress to the following: 1. Internal works:

- Painting works are ongoing at the North Side.
 Plastering works are ongoing at the spiral stairs walls.
- The M&E contractors are readying the pipes and cables for works to the columns in the Nave, and installation of equipment will take place as soon as the scaffolds are removed.

2. Bell Tower:

- Plastering and painting works are ongoing at the lower levels.
- The coloured glass for the Bell Tower windows have been cut to different shapes and are waiting to be installed before the scaffolds come down.

3. External Works:

• The contractor has commenced the washing of the roof slates, which will take about 4-6 weeks.

We continue to pray for the Lord's favour over the restoration –

- for the safety of all workers and the technical team, especially when working at heights;
- for clear weather, so that the works can continue smoothly and safely;
- for skilled workers to be available;
- for a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue with minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources;
- for wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work; and
- for smooth work progress and the speedy completion of the Nave restoration project. "Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labour in vain." (Ps 127:1) ESV


