# PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

### THE WORLD

Pray that world leaders will, collaborate and cooperate with one another, to reach common ground on controversial climate change issues, as they work urgently towards limiting global warming to 1.5 degrees Celsius. Pray that developing countries, which are suffering from the consequences of unprecedented weather phenomenon, will receive the needed financial aid to recover their losses. Pray for the cessation of wars and political tensions, for viable solutions to tackle food, water and energy shortages, that many lives may be preserved. Pray that the gospel of Christ will bring light and hope to the many who are living in hopelessness and despair.

### **SINGAPORE**

A 2015 study by Duke-NUS Medical School found that 2 in 5 Singaporeans aged 62 years and older are lonely. Another study by NUS found that almost 4 in 5 elderly who are socially isolated, lived with their families, compared with 3 in 20 living on their own. Such seniors tend to suffer from increasing loss of resources and ability to participate in social activities. Pray for our government as it reviews its strategy to help the elderly stay active and socially connected. Pray also for caregivers, social agencies and community-support networks to complement our government's efforts in slowing down or preventing social frailty and physical deterioration in our ageing population.

### **DIOCESE**

### **Church of the Good Shepherd**

Pray that many seekers will come to the "Christmas in Queenstown" event, held over the weekends of 8-10 Dec and 15-17 Dec on the church grounds; that they will encounter God in a special way and receive His gift of salvation. Pray that over this Christmas season, the clergy, pastoral, admin staff and members will be actively engaged and fruitful, in evangelism. Pray also for the Youth Camp (28-30 Dec), that the camp committee will be sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit and that God will do a deep work among the youth during the camp.

### **CATHEDRAL**

### Lessons & Carols (17 Dec)

Pray that the true story of the fall of humanity, the promise of the Messiah, and the birth of Jesus will be powerfully communicated through the reading of Scriptures and the signing of Christmas hymns. Pray that our hearts will be filled with love for Jesus, our wills be surrendered to His and our lives will glorify Him. Pray also that the gospel proclaimed will bring many to salvation in Christ.

### Nave Re-opening

Pray that all the remaining works carried out, towards the re-opening of the Nave, will proceed smoothly, safely and in a timely manner. Pray that the newly renovated Nave will be a living sanctuary where God will be pleased to dwell among His people, it will be a house of prayer and a light to the nations.

### OCTOBER 2023 UPDATE ON NAVE RESTORATION WORKS

Testing of Bell tower lighting.

We are now approaching the last leg of a longer than expected run. We continue to thank God for seeing us through every step of the way, providing us with the stamina and strength to take us to where we are now. His provisions are manifold and they continue to flow throughout. We have a great and awesome God, fully worthy of our praise. Thank you so much, Heavenly Father.

Almost all the external scaffolds have been removed, and the internal scaffolds too. Tiling

works are in progress inside the Nave, whilst floor polishing works in both the North Transept Hall and South Transept Hall are nearing completion. We have moved on from mainly masonry and painting works to fitting works, carpentry and M&E works as well as cleaning up works. The following works will be carried out in the Nave from November:-

### 1. M&E

- Installation of air-conditioning fan coil units and condensing units will take place, and we hope to have the air-conditioners up and running by mid-November.
- The lights and fans are currently being installed in the Nave, and we should also have the electrical system for the Nave in place by end November.
- The AV system will be installed from the second week of November, including those in the North Transept Hall and South Transept Hall.

### 2. Carpentry

- The pews have been restored, and we plan to move the pews back into the Nave by the third or fourth week of November.
- Varnishing works to the fixed furniture in the sanctuary are ongoing.
- Re-installation of all doors and windows is ongoing and should be completed by the second week of November.

### 3. External Works:

- Washing of the remaining roof tiles at the North East section of the Cathedral building will take place from the second week of November.
- Part of the hoardings around the Nave will be removed in November. For your own safety, please do not enter the Cathedral building as works will still be ongoing inside the building.

### 4. Cleaning works

- Cleaning works are currently in progress, and more intensive cleaning will take place before the pews are moved back into the Nave.
- The marble flooring in the sanctuary will be cleaned and polished by the second week of November.

We continue to pray for the Lord's favour over the restoration –

- for the safety of all workers and the technical team, especially when working at heights;
- for good weather, so that the works can continue smoothly and safely;
- for skilled workers to be available:
- for a safe and peaceful environment for the work to continue with minimal disruptions and distractions from internal and external sources;
- for wisdom and practical abilities for the project teams to give of their best to this work; and
- for smooth work progress and the completion of the Nave restoration project.
