THE WORLD

As elections conclude in Pakistan, it remains unclear who will form the next government since no party won a simple majority. Pray for political stability in the midst of allegations of fraud and vote rigging; for political leaders and their parties to work towards the formation of a strong coalition government; for the establishment of good policies that will aid economic recovery and strengthen the social fabric of the nation. Pray for the long drawn wars in Ukraine, Myanmar and Gaza to be resolved and for an end to the suffering of millions.

SINGAPORE

Pray for our government as they formulate policies and take practical steps to advance mental health care in Singapore. Pray for the successful implementation of measures, which include, equipping all our polyclinics and general practitioner clinics to provide mental health services by 2030, providing private insurance coverage to persons with mental health conditions and making mental healthcare more accessible to the community. Pray for a larger pool of public sector psychiatrists and psychologists and for increased capacity in government hospitals to provide long term care for patients with severe and chronic mental health illnesses.

Pray for candidates who are preparing for their confirmation on 3 March 2024, by Archbishop Titus Chung, for their knowledge of God's word to deepen and for them to have an intimate relationship with Him. Pray for a greater measure of the in filling of the Holy Spirit to serve and glorify God. Pray for the church as it goes through a leadership transition, for Canon Lewis Lew's healing and recovery, and for Revd Jonathan Wong as he takes on the role as Acting Vicar during Canon Lewis' medical leave.
