PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Pray for the safe evacuation of Palestinian civilians before any ground assault on Rafah; for the release of hostages still held in captivity and for the avoidance of a humanitarian catastrophe in Gaza. Pray for the government and trainee doctors in South Korea to find common ground in resolving the country's shortage of doctors. Pray that farmers in India will receive a minimum price for their produce to ensure their livelihoods. Pray that as the world goes through many challenges on the political, social and economic fronts, God's people will be salt and light in places of darkness and God's Kingdom will continue to advance.

SINGAPORE

Pray for our government as they study the global economic landscape and review Singapore's economic policies to ensure we retain our competitive edge as an attractive investment destination. Pray for the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore as they launch initiatives in the airline, airport and traffic management domains, to decarbonise Singapore's aviation sector while supporting sustainable growth. Pray that these initiatives will achieve their targeted aims.

DIOCESE

Pray that a new generation of Youth Pastors will be raised and for smooth ministry succession. Pray also for St Peter's Hall in their role as our Diocesan training arm, as they equip pastors and lay people to serve in our parishes.

Pray for the Deans of Laos and Nepal, Home Base Coordinators, missionaries, priests and staff of churches in these Deaneries; that God will bless the work of their hands, grant them wisdom to shepherd His people and build His church, raise up local leadership and bring His light and love to the nations they serve.

Baptism & Confirmation Course (beginning 3 March)

Pray for our brothers and sisters who will be starting the baptism and confirmation course on 3 March, that the teaching and small group discussions will ground them in the faith. Pray for God's anointing upon the instructors and small group facilitators as they teach and facilitate the learning of our candidates.

Mission trip to Cambodia (4 to 10 March 2024)

Pray for the mission team to discern God's clear leading and direction during this trip, for divine connections and appointments and for His enabling to accomplish His divine assignments. Pray for team unity, members' good health and divine protection over them and their families. Pray for safe travel by air and land, for good weather and safe road conditions.
