PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Pray for as many land, sea and air channels as possible, to be opened for urgent humanitarian aid to reach the hundreds of thousands of Palestinians in Gaza; for a deal to be reached between Israel and Hamas to secure a temporary ceasefire in Gaza and the release of hostages. Pray for the safety of civilians caught in the crossfire and for the humane treatment of hostages. Pray also against the use of nuclear weapons in the Ukraine war and for an end to the suffering of the people. Pray that many will turn to the Lord who alone gives hope to a troubled world plagued by wars, political tensions and power struggles.

SINGAPORE

Pray for continued good bilateral relations between Singapore and Australia and for strategic ways to deepen cooperation especially in the green and digital economies. Pray that the governments of ASEAN and Australia will continue to work together to establish an open, inclusive and stable region. On the national front, pray that we will safeguard the social cohesion in multi-racial Singapore in the midst of the Israel-Hamas conflict. Pray for our military and police force to be vigilant in dealing with external and internal threats to our national security.

DIOCESE

Church of the Ascension, Church of the Good Shepherd

Pray for the Vicars, clergy and staff of Church of the Ascension and Church of the Good Shepherd, to have divine wisdom and insight, to shepherd their members in God's ways, that they may grow strong in faith and be committed disciples of Christ. Pray that these two churches will be salt and light to their neighbouring communities, that many will come to know Christ, through their loving acts and vibrant witness.

Myanmar Service

Pray for God's enabling and empowerment upon the priest-in-charge of our Myanmar Service and the leadership team. Pray that members of this congregation will be strong in faith in the midst of the current situation in Myanmar. Pray for godly men and women to rise up to positions of leadership and for members to be zealous in their witness for Christ.

Wednesday 12.30pm Service

Pray that the Wednesday 12.30pm Service will be a river of life that refreshes and nourishes the spiritually thirsty, especially those who are working around the vicinity of the Cathedral as well as the tourists. Pray that many will encounter our Lord through the warm welcome of His people, the preaching of His word and the celebration of the Holy Eucharist.

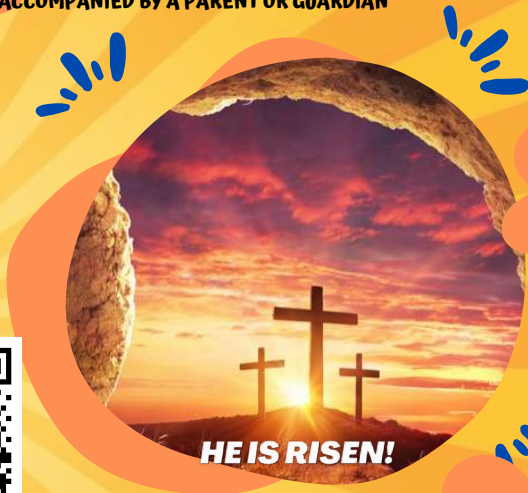

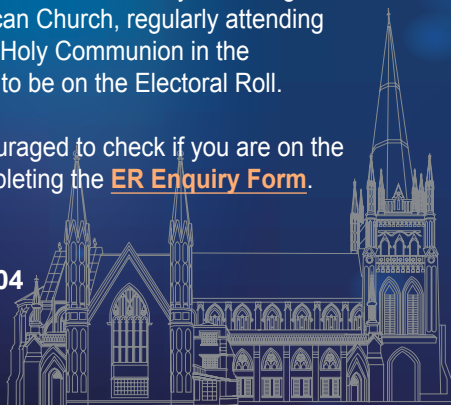

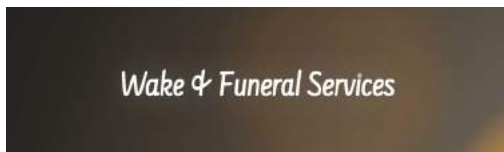
