PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Pray for good coordination among countries who are organizing the delivery of food supplies to the people in Gaza by land, air and sea. Pray for the safety of those who are involved in the operations and for timely aid to reach those in dire need. Pray for Israel and Hamas to reach consensus as talks continue to secure a ceasefire and the release of hostages. Pray also for the de-escalation of tensions between North and South Korea.

SINGAPORE

Pray that Singapore will have divine wisdom to contribute to the fight against the global drug problem as a newly elected member of the United Nation's Commission on Narcotic Drugs. Pray for our Home Affairs and Foreign Affairs ministries as well as government agencies as they work with the international community to develop effective prevention strategies to stop drug abuse and its harmful effects on societies. Pray also for our Central Narcotics Bureau to have wisdom to tackle the problem of drug abuse in Singapore, especially among the young.

DIOCESE

Pray for our Archbishop, the Most Revd Dr Titus Chung, clergy, deaconesses and staff in the different parishes of our Diocese as they prepare for the various Services during Holy Week. Pray for divine wisdom and for the Holy Spirit's enabling to preach God's Word and to lead God's people, as we follow our Lord Jesus

Christ to the cross and celebrate His resurrection. Pray that through the messages shared, many hearts will embrace the Saviour of the world and receive eternal life in Him.

Deanery of Indonesia

Pray for the recruitment of students for Anglican Theological College Indonesia and the start of the school year on 12 August 2024, for the construction of St Andrew's School, Kuantana, that the construction of the campus would be finished by July 2024. Pray for an increase in enrolment for all our Anglican schools for the new school year and for funds to complete the purchase of a shophouse for St Peter's Church, Bandung.

CATHEDRAL

As God has planted us in the heart of the city, pray that Cathedral will be a church that is alive in Christ, proclaiming God's truth, sharing His love and reflecting His glory to a world in need. Pray that in His church, the weary will find rest, the wounded will find healing, the despairing will find hope and the lost will find their way home to God.

Pray that God will anoint the preaching of His word at the various services during Holy Week. Pray that we will embrace His agape love and we will respond with deep gratitude and in true worship, in the total consecration and surrender of our lives completely to Him.

ST ANDREW'S CATHEDRAL ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Notice is hereby given that the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Parish of St Andrew's Cathedral will be held on 21 April 2024 (Sunday) at 2pm at the Cathedral New Sanctuary (CNS), St Andrew's Cathedral.

ELECTORAL ROLL

Members who wish to vote at the AGM must be on the Electoral Roll (ER) of St Andrew's Cathedral. Baptised members who are at least 17 years of age, confirmed in the Anglican Church, regularly attending Service and partaking Holy Communion in the Cathedral, are eligible to be on the Electoral Roll. Members may check if you are on the Electoral Roll by submitting the [ER Enquiry Form](#), and update your particulars by submitting the [Membership Update Form](#).

The Electoral Roll membership for the purposes of AGM 2024 shall be the prevailing enrolled members on the Electoral Roll at the date of the AGM. If you are not on the Electoral Roll but are eligible, please submit your ER Application Form (available by request from membership@cathedral.org.sg) before 11:59am on 14 April 2024 (Sunday) if you wish to be eligible to vote at the AGM 2024.

AGM ATTENDANCE

The quorum for the AGM may be formed only by members on the Electoral Roll who are *physically present* at the AGM.

Members are encouraged to pre-register their attendance at the AGM by submitting the [AGM 2024 Registration Form](#) before 11:59am on 18 April 2024 (Thursday), to allow checks on ER status to be conducted beforehand in order to facilitate faster registration and entry into the AGM.

Members who do not pre-register will be able to attend and vote at the AGM, subject to verification at the door prior to their entry into the AGM that they are on the Electoral Roll. We seek members' patience and understanding for any wait and delay due to the need to conduct the ER checks at the door for members who have not pre-registered their attendance at the AGM.

ANNUAL REPORT, FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND BUDGET

Members may download the [Annual Report](#) directly from the Cathedral website.

Members who are on the Electoral Roll and who submit the [AGM 2024 Registration Form](#) before 11:59am on 18 April 2024 (Thursday) will receive *soft copies* of the Annual Report, Financial Statements and Budget before the AGM.

Please note that we are going paperless as much as possible for a better environment, and hard copies of the documents will *not* be generally available.

NOMINATIONS FOR ELECTION TO THE PAROCHIAL CHURCH COUNCIL

The AGM will elect the People's Warden and 12 members of the Parochial Church Council (PCC).

According to the St Andrew's Cathedral Constitution, candidates for election to membership of the Parochial Church Council shall be on the Electoral Roll of the Parish and must be nominated by writing from one member and seconded by another to the Honorary Secretary at least 08 days prior to the AGM subject to prior written consent to nomination by the candidate. The Candidate, Proposer and Secunder must all be members on the Cathedral Electoral Roll.

[PCC Nomination Forms](#) are available from the Cathedral website and during office hours from the Cathedral staff office at the South Transept, Level 2. The nomination forms shall be submitted by electronic means, or by hand/post to Secretariat, St Andrew's Cathedral, 11 St Andrew's Road, Singapore 178959, before 11:59am on 06 April 2024 (Saturday).

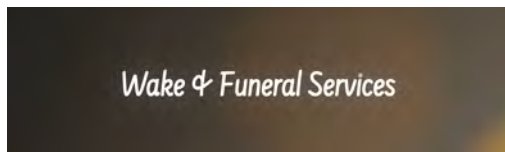
