PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Pray for a peaceful resolution of the war in Ukraine; that military support by Western nuclear powers will not lead to a direct clash with Russia, which could result in catastrophic consequences. Pray for the Korean government and medical professionals to resolve their differences, reach a consensus and restore their healthcare system. Pray for Taiwan as it continues to grapple with the many aftershocks from the deadly earthquake that hit Hualien on 3 April. Pray for stability to be restored so that search and rescue operations can resume. Pray for the more than 1,000 people who were injured and for the families of at least 16 people who were killed.

SINGAPORE

Pray for our Deputy Prime Minister Lawrence Wong as he prepares to take on the role of Singapore's next Prime Minister on 15 May. Pray that he will have divine wisdom to make the right appointments in the formation of his new Cabinet. Pray for favour with global leaders as he continues to build on the goodwill that PM Lee Hsien Loong and others have established over the years. Pray that he will be able to rally the people of Singapore together as he envisions a shared future for us, as one united people.

DIOCESE

Deaneries of Thailand and Vietnam

Pray for the Deans, Home Base Coordinators, priests and leaders of the local churches in the Deaneries of Thailand and Vietnam. Pray that God

will grant them divine strategies to shepherd and disciple the flocks under their charge, reach out to the lost, plant new churches and raise up the local leadership in their respective Deaneries. Pray that churches in these two Deaneries will be vibrant communities that reflect God's love and bear witness to the gospel.

Newly elected Parochial Church Council

Pray for the newly elected members of the PCC, that they will be led and empowered by the Holy Spirit to serve the Lord and to build His church in their term of office.

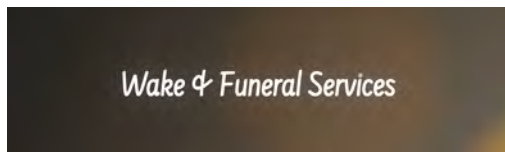
