THE WORLD

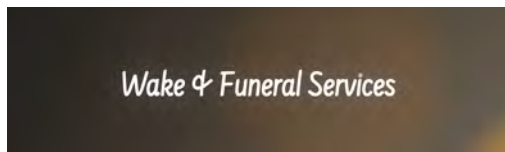
