THE WORLD

Pray for countries in South Asia that are experiencing extreme heavy rainfall as well as record-breaking temperatures as a result of climate change. Pray for those who have lost loved ones, homes, and livelihoods; for the injured to recover; and for the displaced to be resettled. Pray especially for the people of Papua New Guinea, where a recent massive landslide crashed through a village, burying more than 2,000 people, 150 homes, and displacing more than 1,250 people. Rescue and relief efforts have been severely hampered by the remote location of the village, the severance of the only road link, and the threat of further landslides. Pray for those who lost loved ones to be comforted, for those at risk to be evacuated to safety, for protection over the rescue teams in their recovery efforts, and for the government to work with international aid agencies to help the afflicted.

SINGAPORE

Thank God for preserving this little red dot and for sustaining us through turbulent times. Pray that we will be mindful of how vulnerable we are and how much we need His grace. Pray that God will enable our government leaders to be proactive in planning Singapore's future and that in every policy decision, they will be guided by His divine wisdom. Pray that Singapore will be a nation that upholds righteousness, a nation with close community bonds where everyone plays their part in building a strong, harmonious, and caring society.

Registration Exercise for Admission to Primary One (Phase 2B) in 2025 for Anglican Schools

MOE has announced the dates for Phase 2B of the Primary One registration:

From: 9am, Monday 22 July 2024 To: 4.30pm, Tuesday 23 July 2024

For children born between 2 Jan 2018 and 1 Jan 2019 (both dates inclusive) and who are Singapore Citizens or Singapore Permanent Residents whose parent/s are Anglican Church Members. Foreign students are not eligible for Phase 2B registration.


