### THE WORLD

Pray for the de-escalation of tensions between North and South Korea over recent provocations and between China and the Philippines over territorial claims in the South China Sea. Thank God for enabling Singapore to host the recently concluded Shangri-La Dialogue, which created an important space for communication among world leaders in an era of complex geopolitics. Pray that Singapore will continue to play a useful role in the international arena and contribute towards the maintenance of peace, economic growth, and the resolution of global issues. Pray also for our researchers and urban planners as they look into developing solutions to tackle Singapore's urban heat problem and make living spaces in built-up areas more thermally comfortable for people.

MOE has announced the dates for Phase 2B of the Primary One registration:

From: 9am, Monday 22 July 2024 To: 4.30pm, Tuesday 23 July 2024

For children born between 2 Jan 2018 and 1 Jan 2019 (both dates inclusive) and who are Singapore Citizens or Singapore Permanent Residents whose parent/s are Anglican Church Members. Foreign students are not eligible for Phase 2B registration.


