As we commemorate Youth Weekend, may we be reminded that our Cathedral youths are a precious part of our church! Do we have hopes for a brighter future for SAC? I'm sure we do! These hopes cannot be realised without our youths! When we invest in our young people, we are investing in the future of our church.

As we ponder the above quote, many of us will recall Paul's words to Timothy: "I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well. For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands, for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control." Those formative years were crucial, and I wouldn't be where I am today without their efforts to disciple me.

I pray that we in SAC will heed the call to mentor and disciple our youths—spending time with them, listening to them, sharing with them, and helping them to grow. It might surprise us how much we can receive as we give ourselves to them. This is a work with eternal consequences that's richly rewarding! So let's all do our part to fan their fire for God. May we raise up a generation whose spiritual zeal will light the path to a brighter future for His Church!

The United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund (UNICEF) is an agency of the United Nations responsible for providing humanitarian and developmental aid to children worldwide.
