# PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

## THE WORLD

Pray also for a cessation of violence and human suffering in many parts of our world that are at war or involved in conflict; for the gospel of peace and hope to continue to advance in the midst of chaos, devastation and loss.

## SINGAPORE

As we look forward to celebrating Singapore's 59th National Day on 9 August, we thank God for watching over our nation and for sustaining us through the past 59 years. We acknowledge that it is God who has helped us overcome the many difficulties and challenges we faced from the days of our founding fathers to the present. We thank God for giving us good government and leaders who have led Singapore with foresight, fortitude and compassion. Pray for our fourth generation leaders under our new Prime Minister, Mr Lawrence Wong, that God will grant them divine wisdom, courage and strength to govern Singapore amid multiple challenges. Pray for a meaningful National Day celebration, for the safety of all involved in the National Day Parade and for Singaporeans to stay united, with a deep

sense of commitment to build a shared future together, with the help of our Almighty God.

### Yishun Christian Church (Anglican)

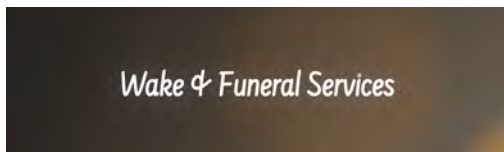
