THE WORLD

Bangladesh was thrown into a state of political uncertainty after her Prime Minister, Ms Sheikh Hasina, resigned and fled the country after weeks of deadly unrest by hundreds of student demonstrators. The student movement protested against the reinstatement of a quota that reserved 30% of government jobs for children of the veterans of Bangladesh's 1971 independence war. They argued that the quota system was discriminatory and benefitted supporters of the PM's political party. More than 300 people have been killed since protests began. A new interim government has been formed, led by Bangladesh's economist and banker, Mr Muhammad Yunus. Pray that he and his team will be able to restore peace and law and order as well as political stability in the country. Pray also that heightened tensions and the volatile situation in the Middle East will not escalate into a regional war. Pray that the gospel will continue to advance and that many who are living in fear and despair will find hope and salvation in Christ.

SINGAPORE

Pray for our Prime Minister, Mr Lawrence Wong, and his 4G team, that they will have divine wisdom to govern this nation in the ways of righteousness and justice, be good stewards of our nation's resources, strengthen our system of social support, look after the healthcare needs of a fast-ageing population, promote active ageing, uplift lower-wage workers, support vulnerable families, and boost retirement adequacy. Pray that Singaporeans will continue to make every effort to maintain racial and religious harmony and build a caring society in the midst of a troubled and fragmented world.

DIOCESE

Chapel of Christ the King (CCK)

Pray that members of CCK will experience renewed and vibrant spiritual vitality as they faithfully live out God's word in their daily lives. Pray that God will open many doors of opportunity for CCK to forge meaningful collaborations with other parishes. Pray also that God will bless and prosper CCK's chaplaincy work in St Margaret's Primary School; that the students may encounter the Lord through the chaplaincy ministry and their lives will be transformed by the power of the Holy Spirit.
