

DIOCESAN EDUCATION MONTH 2024 SEPTEMBER

The Anglican Church serves 3 primary schools, 5 secondary schools and 1 junior college as well as 2 schools for children with special needs. The Education Mission Fund (EMF) was set up with the bequest of Mr Tan Lye Whatt, a former Principal of St Andrew's School with the intention to support and strengthen school chaplaincy work. The EMF is current being managed by the Diocesan Education Board.

Since 2016, parishes and chaplaincy staff involved in the chaplaincy work in the schools have benefited much with access to subsidies for training and hiring needs with the EMF.

The projected fund for the needs of the chaplaincy work is \$\$100,000 annually.



Go and Do Likewise

n the late seventies, St Andrew's Cathedral recognised the needs of Singapore's greying population and the need for the Cathedral to make provisions for elderly members who have no family to care for and support them. The lesson in the Gospel made it compelling for such a response. In the parable of the Good Samaritan, Jesus painted a vivid scene of a loving and caring individual going to the rescue of a needy stranger, ministering to him and arranging for his accommodation and care. Jesus added to his story the command to "Go and do likewise." Thus, the Home opened its doors on 11 Oct 1980.

St Andrew's Cathedral Home is a residential home in Clementi for ambulant older women and provides services to the underserved.



Cathedral Women's Fellowship monthly activity at the Home

The Home provides for the physical, spiritual and emotional well-being of the residents. Attention is paid to the physical environment and care the residents receive; the interaction they continue to have with the larger community - friends and relatives, church, neighbourhood and the experience of God's love and provision. It is a home where the residents can call their own.

The Home is financed primarily through donations and fees that the residents pay, but these are kept low to ensure affordability for the residents. Expenses to run the operations of the Home are not insignificant, and have been increasing, and so, donations are very much welcomed. As the Home has been approved as an Institution of Public Character

(IPC), all outright donations are eligible for 2.5 times tax deduction. Details for donations can be found by clicking or scanning the QR code.
