PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Pray that retaliatory threats exchanged between Israel and Iran will not spiral out of control and escalate into a regional war which may involve more countries. Pray for restraint from acts of violence and for peaceful negotiations to end the fighting and stop the further loss of precious lives in the Middle East. Pray that tensions between China and Taiwan, North and South Korea, will ease and for divine intervention to bring an end to the long-standing hostilities between these nations. Pray that the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ will continue to make inroads into troubled areas and that those suffering from the losses or war, will turn to Christ and find true peace in Him.

SINGAPORE

The recent spate of viral videos of bullying incidents involving primary and secondary school students have been concerning. Pray for the Ministry of Education as they work with our schools to share good practices and review strategies to manage bullying; that teachers will be well-trained and equipped to help students resolve disagreements respectfully, recognise distressed students and proactively address hurtful behaviours. Pray that teachers and school counsellors will provide the needed emotional support to help victims heal and perpetrators rehabilitate. Pray for partnership with parents to create caring and safe learning environments for our students. Pray that our young people will know Christ's love

for them and find in Him, true meaning and purpose in a life.

DIOCESE

St Andrew's City Church

Pray that the carolling teams will enjoy the preparation process and the home visitations during the Christmas outreach; that the various groups involved in the Christmas Outreach Service will be joyful in proclaiming the good news of Jesus Christ. Pray that members and staff will continually carve out time and space to sit with the LORD, enjoy His presence and have honest conversations with him. Pray that God grant the church wisdom to make the best use of the worship space as the church grows and grant the leaders grace to understand the needs of the parish as the church considers another place of worship.

CATHEDRAL

Pray for good attendance at our forthcoming Prayer & Praise on 25 October; that we will be a church that desires to be in God's presence and to seek God's face; that we will prioritise prayer in our corporate life and know God's pleasure as we come together in united prayer. The Most Revd Dr Titus Chung appointed as Chairman of CCEA
The Council of the Church of East Asia (CCEA) has, at its Full Assembly on
13 October 2024, appointed our Diocesan Bishop, Archbishop Dr Titus Chung,
as Chairman of CCEA, with effect from 14 October 2024.

CCEA is a fellowship network of the Anglican churches in East Asia.

Members of CCEA include Archbishops, Bishops, Assistant Bishops, Clergy, and Lay people from the Anglican churches in South East Asia, Myanmar,

Hong Kong, Japan, Korea, the Philippines and Taiwan as well as representatives from the two associate members of CCEA: the Anglican Church of Australia and the Philippine Independent Church, which is in full communion with the Anglican Communion. The Council conducts its Full Assembly once every four years to elect its Executive Committee.

Let us keep Archbishop Titus in prayer as he takes on this new and important responsibility.
