#### THE WORLD

China has seen remarkable growth, becoming the second-largest economy in the world, with powerful global influence. Yet, despite these advancements, the Chinese Communist Party maintains its stance of atheism. Pray for the Church in China, that Christians would remain steadfast in their faith, growing deeper in their relationship with the Lord despite the challenges they face; for the Church to be a beacon of light, fulfilling the Great Commission both within China and beyond its borders. Pray for the children and young people in China to have life-changing encounters with Jesus, pursuing Him passionately from a young age; that the Chinese Church would have continued access to training and resources to strengthen their faith and witness. Pray for the government, that God would touch the hearts of the leaders and that they may know Him.

#### **SINGAPORE**

Pray for continued collaboration between Singapore and China, especially in areas of finance, green development, biomedical sciences, and the digital economy. Pray that both nations would benefit from these partnerships and work together for mutual growth and progress. Pray also for the next generation of leaders, that God may raise up wise and visionary leaders in both Singapore and China, who will deepen mutual understanding and build trust, paving the way for stronger cooperation and peace.

## **Deanery of Cambodia**

Pray for the Dean, Revd Steven Seah, Home-based Coordinators, Revd Martin Jungnickel & Revd Luke Ting, and priests & staff of the churches in Cambodia, that they may be led by the Holy Spirit as they serve God in their various capacities in the Deanery of Cambodia. Pray for the year-end outreach programs in the provinces of Kampong

Pray also that the presence of God would saturate every aspect of the school and that His glory would be revealed in the lives of the students, staff, and community members.

#### **Alpha**

Alpha is a programme where people can explore the Christian faith, ask questions, and experience the love of God. Many have come to Christ through this course. We praise God for the fruit of Alpha and celebrate the lives that have been transformed through Alpha. We thank God for enabling Cathedral to host numerous Alpha courses through the years and pray that He will continue to use us to reach out to the unsaved. Pray for more facilitators and volunteers and for God to continue raising up passionate leaders and volunteers to support and grow this vital ministry.



In 2005, St Andrew's Cathedral recognised the need to reach out to vulnerable children in primary schools. Many of them had working parents, some of whom struggled to make ends meet. There were also children from single or absent-parent families. These children often lacked the adult guidance needed to help them grow, learn, and thrive.

CITY Community Services (CITY) was thus set up in 2007 with the aim of building good character in vulnerable school children.

CITY believes in expressing Christian love by providing practical assistance to children in a safe, caring and supportive learning environment. By developing strong relationships with them and guiding them through their formative years, we help these children overcome educational and family challenges so that they can grow up to be useful members of society.

## Tim is a beneficiary of CITY, and this is his testimony.

"When I was in Primary 5, CITY's Befrienders Club (BC) was a place where I could genuinely share my thoughts, feelings or concerns. It was the first time I felt a sense of belonging. BC helped me through a tough period, when I only had my mother. They helped me to spend my time productively, through lessons and the playing of tchoukball.

I was invited by my fellow BC befrienders to join the Befrienders Alumni programme (BFA) when I entered secondary school. I agreed because I enjoyed being part of the community.

BFA helped me in many different ways - from teaching me how to manage personal issues, assisting me in getting a scholarship, to giving me opportunities to serve as a Student Leader in CITY camps. BFA helped me to grow as a person. Without its guidance, I would have gone astray. I am grateful to the staff for imparting valuable life lessons to me and giving me the chance to serve BFA and the CITY community.

I am also thankful to have met my mentors, Michael and Phoebe, through BFA. During the lowest point of my life, they listened to me, guided me, and journeyed with me. They also shared the gospel with me. Initially I was skeptical, as I have had unpleasant experiences with Christians and churches in the past. However, Michael and Phoebe shared God's love with me in a warm and gentle manner, allowing me to experience God in a wonderful and loving way.

I accepted Jesus as my Saviour because of an answered prayer. At that time, I prayed and told Him that I would accept Him if I was granted an interview for a scholarship that I had applied

for. Not only was I granted the interview, I was eventually awarded the scholarship. I then believed that God was real and that God answered prayers. It is through CITY that I came to Christ."
