THE WORLD

Lift up those who have lost loved ones and those suffering physical and emotional trauma. Pray for healing, comfort, and strength in their distress. Pray that the peace of the Lord would cover Myanmar. May His love be a shelter to the lost, broken, and weary, offering hope and refuge in the midst of this difficult time.

SINGAPORE

As Singapore prepares for the General Election, pray that God will guide all contesting parties in the careful and prayerful selection of their candidates. May they choose individuals with integrity, wisdom, and a strong sense of responsibility towards the nation. Lift up the candidates, and pray that they will be ethical in their conduct, reflecting values that promote strong families, respect for all individuals, and a compassionate approach to the diverse needs of society. Let us also pray for God to appoint the right leaders for Singapore, according to His purpose for the nation. May His divine will be done in the election, ensuring that the leaders chosen will

serve with humility, wisdom, and a heart for the nation's prosperity and peace.

DIOCESE

Deanery of Indonesia

Pray for the recruitment of new students for our Anglican Theological College Indonesia: that the Lord will raise up labourers in the harvest field and for many young people to respond to God's calling for their lives. Pray for leadership succession in the Deanery of Indonesia: for the current leadership to step up in order to take the Anglican Church of Indonesia further. Pray that the Lord open opportunities for church planting and Christian ministry in the provinces in Indonesia where there is no Anglican presence.

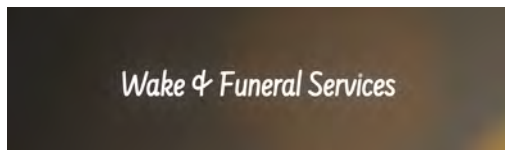
