PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

Let us press on with prayer as we lift up Ukraine and Russia, two nations still caught in the grip of conflict and suffering. As the war stretches on, may our prayers rise like incense—for peace, mercy, and divine intervention. Ask the Lord to bring a swift and just end to the war, and that even in the darkest moments, many would encounter His grace, His comfort, and His strength to endure. Let us lift up the people of Rome and the global Catholic community as they mourn the passing of Pope Francis, their spiritual leader. We pray for peace and comfort to rest upon all who feel this loss deeply, and for wisdom and unity as the Vatican City enters a time of leadership transition.

SINGAPORE

Pray for the Economic Resilience Taskforce, chaired by Deputy Prime Minister (DPM) and Minister for Trade and Industry Gan Kim Yong, which has been set up to help businesses and workers navigate the immediate uncertainties arising from the US tariffs and related global developments, strengthen our nation's resilience, and to position Singapore to thrive in the new economic landscape. Pray for DPM Gan and members of the taskforce to have godly wisdom and discernment in their decision-making, for effective strategies to mitigate economic challenges, and for God's provision and guidance for businesses and individuals affected by economic uncertainties.

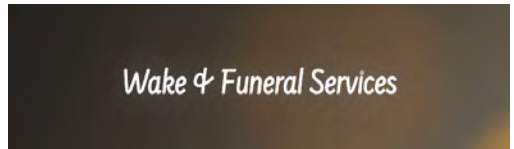

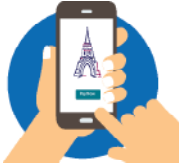
