## SINGAPORE

Thank the Lord for the conclusion of the elections and for His hand over the entire process. Let us lift up in prayer every elected candidate as they prepare to serve the nation with integrity, humility, and wisdom. Pray for unity in Parliament—that all parties will set aside division, respect one another's views, and commit to working together as one team to build the nation. We also pray for healing among all Singaporeans. As the election season comes to a close, may the Lord help us to move forward in unity, setting our hearts on the shared future of our country.

### Westside Anglican Church

Pray that the church will continue to work closely with Saint Andrew's Mission School as
