PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

In these troubled times, let us remember nations caught in deep conflict. May God's mercy flow like healing waters over the broken and the grieving. For Israel and Gaza: As ceasefire talks resume, pray for a breakthrough that will bring about a lasting end to the bloodshed. Ask the Lord to move mightily - to soften hardened hearts, to give divine wisdom to leaders on both sides, and to shield the innocent from harm. For Russia and Ukraine: Continue to pray for an end to the war and the restoration of peace. Ask for God's intervention to stop the fighting and the loss of lives. Pray for healing, reconciliation, and for those suffering to find hope and comfort in Christ.

SINGAPORE

Thank the Lord for His continued grace upon Singapore—blessing us with peace, stability, and the capacity to grow. Praise God for the groundbreaking of Changi Airport Terminal 5, a sign of His provision and guidance. As we celebrate this milestone, let us remember and lift up a vital group, our migrant workers, whose labour helps build our nation's future. Pray for their daily safety and protection in their physically demanding work. Pray they are treated fairly, with dignity and are paid just wages. Most importantly, pray they will encounter the love of Christ during their time here and come to know Jesus as Lord and Saviour. As God blesses our nation, may we be a blessing to those He has brought to our land.

DIOCESE

Deaneries of Laos & Nepal

Pray for the deans, home base co-ordinators, priests and staff of the local churches in the Deaneries of Laos and Nepal, that God grant them wisdom, courage and strength as they continue to watch over flock and mission fields in these two deaneries. Pray for continued spiritual growth of church members, the raising of godly men and women to leadership roles and for the gospel to advance, especially in unreached places, that the light of Christ will bring hope and salvation to the people of these lands.

CATHEDRAL

Let us pray that our Cathedral family will respond faithfully to God's Great Commission—to *"go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit"* (Matthew 28:19).

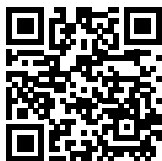

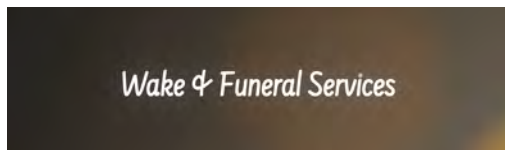
