PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

THE WORLD

The Rohingya are a Muslim minority who have lived for centuries in what is now northern Myanmar. Once recognized as equal citizens, they were stripped of their citizenship in 1982 under military rule, leaving them stateless. Tensions escalated into violence in 2012, displacing thousands and destroying entire villages. Today, many Rohingya live in refugee camps or ghettos, while others have fled to neighbouring countries—often facing danger, exploitation, and trafficking along the way. Pray

- For justice and a peaceful resolution to this long-standing conflict.
- That the Rohingya would be able to live in safety and dignity—both in their homeland and in the countries where they seek refuge.
- For global efforts working to protect, restore, and provide hope for the Rohingya community—especially for the children growing up in such uncertain conditions.

Let us lift up these brothers and sisters with compassion, asking God to move powerfully on their behalf. May the Rohingya also find faith and comfort in our loving God, and rest in His peace and safety.

SINGAPORE

As a small nation in a rapidly changing world, Singapore's ties with our ASEAN neighbors are vital. In the face of economic uncertainty, climate challenges, political tensions, and shifting global dynamics, unity and wise collaboration within our region are more important than ever. Pray:

- That Singapore will continue to build strong, peaceful, and constructive relationships with all ASEAN nations.
- For God's wisdom and discernment to guide our government in fostering cooperation that brings mutual benefit and long-term stability.
- That Singapore will be a channel of God's

goodness and mercy to our neighbours—reflecting His love through diplomacy, partnership, and shared progress. May our region be strengthened in unity and peace, and may Singapore serve as a blessing to those around us.

DIOCESE

Pray for our Archbishop The Most Revd Dr Titus Chung as he provides leadership and oversight to the Diocese of Singapore's 27 local parishes, 7 deanery countries, 11 schools, 18 preschools and 42 healthcare and community services under the Singapore Anglican Community Services and St Andrew's Mission Hospital, in addition to his roles and responsibilities in the wider Body of Christ. Pray for divine guidance, wisdom and strength to fulfil God's mandate for our Diocese in these difficult and challenging times. Pray also for strong collaborations as our Diocesan office holders, staff, clergy and laity unite to build and strengthen God's Church and to advance His Kingdom.

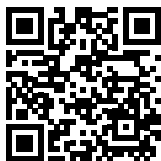

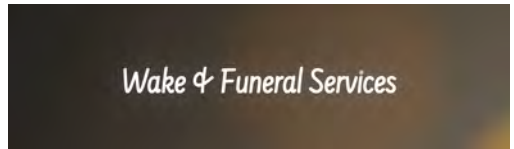
